Thursday Oct 3^d
 Weather Cloudy fresh breeze from the N.E. steering
 SW by S. nothing in sight, at sundown. Last part
 overcast wind NE by E. 2 sails in sight. Lat. 13. 54
 Long. 22. 11

Friday Oct 4th
 Weather ~~cloudy~~ moderate breeze from ENE. steering
 SW by S. took a longer distance which put us 15 miles to
 eastward of chronometer. Last part Cloudy. rigged fore
 and close some Hockemithus. Lat 11. 08 N.
 Long 22. 08 W.

Saturday Oct 5th Long 22. 08 W.
 Weather Cloudy strong breeze from NE. steering SW by S
 at 4 raised vessel on Starboard side which appeared to
 be whaling. luffed to on starboard tack and ran for him
 proved to be the Leonidas. Last luff, sailed in Aug. 67 clear
 last part squally wind changing from NE. to SE with
 rain hauled main, staggail and bedient cask for water.

Sunday Oct 6th
 Rainy weather water employed in catching water
 on the wind on port tack under short sail heading S.W.
 last part calm raised Blackfish at 9 Am lowered
 and got 3 (starboard board 2 and bow 1.) took them along
 side and cut them in. Lat 10. 38

Monday Oct 7th Long 22. 08
 Weather fine with light air from Coffline winds. lowered
 for Blackfish did not strike. Last part squally with
 rain hauled out Blackfish turned up 2 1/2 bl.

Tuesday Oct 8th
 First part pleasant light wind from E. steering SW by W.
 lowered for Blackfish did not strike. there was sail in
 sight one a steamer. at 10 Am. lowered for Blackfish
 did not get fast. 3 sails in sight. Lat 8 57 N.
 Long. 22. 57 W.

Wednesday Oct 9th
 First part pleasant weather light baffling wind ship
 heading to southward. Last part wind by the on port tack
 heading S by W. Lat. 18 36 N.
 Long 23. 01 W

Thursday Oct 10th
 First part Cloudy light air from East on port tack
 heading S by W. lowered for Blackfish at 1 o'clock. pulled
 3 miles and they turned out to be Abacoo. 3 sails in
 sight.

Friday Oct 11th
 First part squally with strong breeze from SE. on port
 tack on the wind. gained the Bark. Leonidas. at 2 Pm.
 broke out No 21 shuck. to see up in making Drugg. &c.
 Lat. 6. 56

Saturday Oct 12th Long 23. 38
 First part cloudy with occasional showers of rain 3 sail
 in sight on port tack heading to S.W. Last part Rainy
 on sail in sight the Bark. Leonidas

Sunday Oct 13th
 First part Rainy on port tack heading to S. at 2 o'clock. air
 changed to S and W. were around heading new 7 Pm. ESE.
 Leonidas on Starboard quarter. Last part pleasant.
 7. 06

Monday Oct 14th 22. 04
 Fine weather moderate breeze from S.W. on Starboard
 tack. last part wind W. on Starboard tack heading S
 two sails in sight. was copying all day.
