Thursday Oct 17th

Weather rough strong wind from SSW on starboard tack commenced boiling at 10 AM. raised whales lowered and Ben boat took one had him alongside by 6 o'clock. Lowered part stony at 5.30 AM. hooked on and cut in whale before breakfast 3 sails in sight.

Friday Oct. 18th Long. 19. 36 W.

Weather cloudy strong wind from Sth on Port tack employed in boiling. There was 4 sailing sight to day last part fine weather wind SSW spit head to Eth - Lat 5. 59 N

Saturday Oct 19th Long. 19. 16

Weather fine light breeze from SSW ship on the wind on Port tack. at 10 AM lowered for Blackfish and got 5. of which 3 B. got 2 there was 1 sail in sight. one whale turned up 6. 7 lbs

Sunday Oct 20th

Weather fine light breeze from WSW heading S. lowered for Blackfish at 4 PM without success. there was 1 sail in sight.

Monday Oct 21st Long. 18. 31

Weather fine ship on Port tack heading to Sth W. there was nothing in sight tried out our Blackfish they turned up 2 lbs.

Tuesday Oct. 22nd

First part cloudy with squalls grain ship heading to Wnd at 6.30 took up ship and stood along on Starboard tack heading SSW. Last part rainy within and calm run down on it into the ground but it amounted to 7. lbs.

Wednesday Oct. 23rd

First part calm and being finished stowing empty cask and cleaning up the barroom. Dull weather and nothing in sight.

Thursday Oct 24th

First part Rainy with all appearances of it ending the same there was a little wind at sundown and ship heading S by W. Last part same have been on both tack today not much of any wind and what there is is from Sth.

Friday Oct 25th

First part rain and calm one sail in sight. Last part weather changed, wind SSW ship heading W by S.

Begins fine weather light breeze from SSW ship heading W by S. 24 sails in sight at sundown. at 9 AM ship Robinson Crusoe Exp. from the Calcutta ran within hail on long 22. 36 S. 19. 04 lowered for Blackfish without success.

First part cloudy light breeze from Sth on Port tack on the wind heading W by S. at sundown there was 3 sails in sight. Last part fine wind same.

Weather fine fresh breeze from South Wnd on Port tack heading WSW the wind has an appearance of the trades. there was nothing in sight. Sent new pit & Main top gallant sail.
