

Wednesday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> 1862.

Commence Cloudy weather strong wind from S.E. at 7 wind hauled to E.S.E. with rain squalls, steering S.W. struck Popoia and saved the lead part same.

Lat 49° 44' S.

Thursday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>

Long 81° 30' W.

Commence strong wind and cloudy weather wind hauling from E.S.E. to W.S.W. on the wind heaving N. Last part same with light breeze W.S.W. Broke out Butter Sugar, &c.

Lat 48° 27' S.

Friday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

Long 80° 20' W.

First part fine weather light breeze & calm. at 7 ship heaving W.S.W. on Starboard tack, hove to for a finback, did not get part.

Last part weather stormy fine drizzling rain on the wind on Starboard tack heaving N.W.

No Observations.

Saturday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

First part rainy weather light breeze from S.W. steering N.W. then were finbacks & Grampus in sight today, at 7 P.M. wind increasing to a gale from S.W. under short sail through the night. Last part weather same, under all sail.

Long 82° 32' W.

Sunday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

Commence strong winds & squalls weather, one sail in sight. Last part moderate wind from S.W. steering N.W.W.

Lat 43° 14' S.

Monday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

Long 79° 44' W.

First part Cloudy weather moderate breeze from W.S.W. steering N.W.W. one sail in sight. Last part foggy weather wind S.W. steering N. three sail in sight (Merchantman)

Lat 41° 49' S.

Tuesday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

Long 79° 03' W.

First part Cloudy weather light breeze from S.W. steering N. Last part same sent up topsail forward, was mending sails all day. 2 sails in sight.

Lat 40° 03' S.

Wednesday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

Long 78° 22' W.

First part fine weather fresh breeze from S. steering N.W. several finbacks in sight. Last part Rough weather stormy S.

Lat 37° 36' S.

Long 77° 25' W.

Grand Nocha

Thursday Jan 30<sup>th</sup>

Commence Strong wind from south & heavy sea, steering N. at 2 P.M. came to in Starboard tack heaving E.S.E. Last part same 3<sup>rd</sup> Mate carried away Main stajpail in Tacking ship.

Lat 37° 30' S.

Long 76° 25' W.

Friday Jan 31<sup>st</sup>

Commence strong wind from S. steering E. under double reefed topsails & courses. Last part moderate breeze from S. at Noon laid in port beam, heaving N.

Lat 37° 40' S.

Long 74° 08' W.

Saturday Feb 1<sup>st</sup>

First part Cloudy light wind from S. increasing about ship and headed to W. on the wind. Last part Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. Cruising on. Nocha was employed in making Nitrous Keggs, spoke R.R. Petrol. Water at 37° 20. had taken 2 whales.

Long 75° 12.

Sunday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commence strong breeze Cloudy. 3 sail in sight. Last part same cruising off Nocha.

Lat 37° 13' S.

Long 74° 30' W.

Monday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commence strong wind cloudy weather at 2 P.M. raised St Mary's Island, at 5. lashed ship stowed off shore, one sail in sight. Last part gale from S. employed in making Keggs.

Lat 37° 17' S.

Tuesday Feb 4<sup>th</sup>

Long 75° 04' W.

Commence rough weather fresh gale from S.W. Cruising off Nocha. Last part weather moderating 2 sail in sight was Coopering, Capt & myself made 9 Nitrous Keggs.

Lat 37° 13' S.

Long 75° 26' W.

Wednesday Feb 5<sup>th</sup>

First part Cloudy weather strong breeze from S.W. cruising. Last part very rough weather wind S.W. one sail in sight was Coopering nothing else of account happened.

Lat 37° 16' S.

Long 75° 26' W.
