Lat 36.37 S  
Long 76.14 W  
Comence fresh Gale from S.E. nothing in sight at sundown.  
Lead part the same.

Monday March 30<sup>th</sup>

Lat 35.37 N  
Long 75.05 W  
Weather Cloudy gale of wind from S.W. laying too on eastern tack. no mast heads up this afternoon on account of the weather. Lead part same very rough.

Tuesday Mar 31<sup>st</sup>

Lat 35.26 S  
Long 74.20 W  
Gale of wind from Souths laying too on Port tack a number of Sulphur bottom whales in sight. Lead part weather moderating a little repaired a water cask

Wednesday April 1<sup>st</sup>

Cloudy weather strong wind from S.W. on port tack under short sail heading to W. Lead part moderate breeze from S.W. nothing in sight rain in equator.

Thursday April 2<sup>nd</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence fresh breeze from S.W. on Port tack at sundown shortened sail. Lead part fine weather wind S.E. steering W. nothing in sight seeing fish line. &c.

Friday April 3<sup>rd</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Fine weather fresh breeze from S.E. steering W at 9.30 Pm raised the Island of Juan Fernandez bearing W.N.W. at sundown shorten sail and came to the wind on Port tack Juan bearing N.W. distant about 30 miles. Lead part wind from W. light.

Saturday April 4<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Fine weather light breeze from W. waist & bow boats went in shore fishing returned at sundown with a fine lot of fish. at 7 came to on Port tack for the night heading W. Lead part hazy weather with light wind and occasional squalls of rain.

Juan Fernandez

Sunday April 5<sup>th</sup> 1868.

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence light wind from S.W. and Cloudy weather, my sail in sight. Cruising. at sundown shortened sail. heading to west on Port tack. Lead part same wind S.W. steering W. Passed <sup>12.20</sup> Masafusa. at day light, return.

Monday April 6<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence fine light breeze from S.W. steering N. at sundown shortened sail. Lead part same painted quarter boat.

Tuesday April 7<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence Cloudy fresh breeze from S.W. steering N. Lead part same nothing in sight. fitted sail to Starboard W. boat. had a rain squall at 10 o'clock.

Wednesday April 8<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence Cloudy with fresh breeze from W.S.W. steering N. Lead part Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. middle watch close reefed fore & main top sail steering N.

Thursday April 9<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S

Comence Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. steering N. shortened sail at sundown sighted St. Ambrose Island. at 9 Am.

Friday April 10<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence fine weather light wind from the south at sundown shifted to wind on Port tack. St. Ambrose about 20 miles distant on a beam. Lead part Calm.

Sunday April 11<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence fine weather light air at sundown light breeze from the West Blackfish in sight at 5 o'clock Pm. Lead part same Cruising to S.E. of St. Ambrose.

Sunday April 12<sup>th</sup>

Lat 34.54 S  
Long 76.59 W  
Comence fine weather light breeze from S.W. at 4 Pm closed 2 gr. boats and went in fishing at a small mee. at 7 Pm. 30 W. Chapel on Course N. with fresh breeze from S.E. Lead part equally from S.E. steering S.
