

Saturday June 13th 1868.

Weather hazy fresh breeze from S.W. at 2 P.M. boat came from shore and hailed. put for powder & bread. at 4 came to anchor on Heambs Shoals, in 14 fathoms water, 5 sails in sight. Last part cloudy occasional squalls of rain Capt. went on board of a shallop schooner, mending main sail.

Sunday June 14th 1868.

Weather Cloudy strong wind from SW. several whales in sight off shore. going quick did not strike. Last part pleasant weather moderate breeze from SE. at 2 P.M. got under way and chased humpbacks without success.

Monday June 15th 1868.

Weather fine chased humpbacks without success at 2 P.M. stood into harbor and anchored in 4 1/2 fathoms water to 30 fathoms cable. Capt. went ashore.

Tuesday June 16th

Weather fine anchored at Heambs got off wood. Last part same got off wood. painted house.

Wednesday June 17th

Weather fine lying at anchor getting off wood schooner. Anter got a whale. Last part light breeze from S.E. got off Orange & sent the hump. on land.

Thursday June 18th big bad pigs, in

Weather Cloudy fresh breeze from S.W. at 2 P.M. got under way and stood out on the shores and came to anchor in 15 fathoms water spoke Anter was cutting in a 40 lb. whale. 6 sails in sight. Last part strong breeze from S.W. Landed for humpback. S.B. slaych.

Friday June 19th

Weather Cloudy fresh breeze from S.W. took whale along side and had him cut in by 6 o'clock. Last part same. at daylight commenced trying out 25 sail in sight.

Saturday June 20th 1868.

Weather fine fresh breeze from S.W. trying out at anchor. gamest John Anita Capt. Ben. Schen. 5 m. out 2 o'clock. Last part same at daylight finished trying out 25 sail at anchor to cruise.

Sunday June 21st

Weather Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. Came to anchor at 4 o'clock in 10 1/2 fathoms water. Was repairing old cask. Last part same. at daylight got under way to cruise for whale.

Monday June 22nd

Weather Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. at 3 came to anchor off Tiger Island 10 o'clock in sight. Last part same got under way at 5 P.M. to cruise.

Tuesday June 23rd

Weather fine fresh breeze from S.W. Landed for whales at 2.5 P.M. going quick did not strike. at 5 spoke John Elfin. Last part strong got under way at daylight Landed for whale going quick.

Wednesday June 24th

Weather rough strong wind from S.W. anchored at 2 P.M. Foris came to anchor also but having an anchor got under way again lying off and on. we had out anchor down & started on a hunt & ready. Last part fine weather lowered for humpback struck and had him cut in by 4.

Thursday June 25th

Weather fine Came to anchor at 2 P.M. cutting up Rube &c. Last part fine weather wind light from W. Landed for humpback. struck cap. & killed her chased the cow until 10 P.M. no sign in sight today.

Friday June 26th

Fine weather light breeze. trying out. at anchor. alight of the garden Place. Last part strong weather lowered for humpbacks without success.

Saturday June 27th

Weather cloudy with occasional squalls of rain wind from W. gamest the Heambs Capt. Lumber. Last part strong got under way at daylight to cruise.
