Lat 1.23 N Weather, inc stormy breeze from S.W. at sundown temp
by 85.48. W. ship and took in light sail heading to windward. Last part
same Coasting.

Wednesday. Oct 28th

Aug. 1. 25 N Weather fine strong breeze from S.W. clouds in the west.
 Aug. 26. 40 W Last part Breeze with moderate breeze from S.W. clearing west.

Thursday, Oct 29th

No Observations. Weather fine moderate breeze from S.W. steering west at sund.
Tackled ship and took in light sail. Lost part of fine weather.

and repaired it.

had seen plenty of whales. Last fair - Cloudy with occasional
squalls of rain.

20.54 N Weather pleasant strong breeze from S.W. on. Starters back.
20.50 W Abington in sight. on weather beam Lead paid same guerd
with Br. Am. Capt. Winslow

Friday Nov. 6th

Weather pleasant moderate breeze from S.E. land in
sight last part same sail in sight traced whale
at 10.30 Am at 11 lowered 4 boats whale going to west

Saturday Nov 7th

Weather fine chased whales untill dark in boat alone
3 Andia 3 Falco, gammed with Andia had taken 40
since leaving Pto. Last part same no land in sight 1
in sight one cutting.

Sunday Nov. 8th

9th. Weather fine moderate breeze from S.W. Cruising same
with Andols. Wenmans Island in sight. At sundown,
