

Monday Nov. 23rd 1868.

Lat. 1.03 N Weather fine light breeze from S^W steering E. anchoring at 11 A.M. 19 W. put back in sight. also Abingdon bearing S.W. by E. last part same.

Tuesday Nov. 24th

Lat. 00 20 N Weather fine moderate breeze from S^W standing E. at 12. Last part same. nothing of account happened.

Wednesday Nov. 25th

Lat. 01 22 S Weather fine moderate breeze from S^W standing to E. at 12. Last part same. wind increasing.

Thursday Nov. 26th

Lat. 01 24 S Weather Cloudy strong breeze occasional squalls of rain. Last part Cloudy strong breeze heading E.

Friday Nov. 27th

Lat. 1. 14 S Weather Cloudy strong breeze from S^W standing to E. at 12. Last part same. nothing of account happened.

Saturday Nov. 28

Lat. 1.22 S Weather fine fresh breeze from S.W. on Starboard. Last part same. Blackfish in sight.

Sunday Nov. 29th

Lat. 1.08 S Weather fine moderate breeze from S.W. standing to E. at 12. Last part Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. heading E. raised the Island of Plata. at 11.

Monday Nov. 30th

Lat. 1.03 N Weather Cloudy strong breeze from S.W. Blackfish in sight. also main land of Plata. at sundown. Tackled ship. Last part same with moderate breeze heading S.W.

Tuesday Dec. 1st

Lat. 2.10 S Weather fine moderate breeze from S.W. heading S. at 12. Last part same. working to windward we sail in sight.

Wednesday Dec. 2nd 1868.

Weather fine moderate breeze from S^W off Point St. Helena. exchanged signals with Bk. Saint Vincent. don't make much to windward. heavy fog at 12. Last part same. strong breeze.

Thursday Dec. 3rd

Weather fine moderate breeze Point St. Helena on horizon distant 25 m. at sundown. one sail in sight. Last part same. dead man's fingers ahead.

Friday Dec. 4

Weather fine fresh breeze from S^W at sundown in 15 fathoms water within 4 miles of Lambay Bar. got up cable and bent anchors. moved back cables got anchors off the bow ready for anchoring. Came to anchor in 10 fathoms. moved to 35 fathoms. Cable at 9 P.M. Capt. came on board the Falcon. Grayhound. Escala. Roscoe. and Bin Sultan. were also anchored here.

Saturday Dec. 5th

Fine weather light breeze. got off raft of water. Falcon. Roscoe. sailed. Last part same.

Sunday Dec. 6th

Weather fine with light breeze in the morning fresh at night. at 6 A.M. got underway and tacked out into 4 fathoms water. Escala got underway at 6 P.M. Bonnet to Panama. Payta.

Monday Dec. 7th

Weather fine Grayhound sailed. sitting up shoals. & running down water. took on board oysters.

Tuesday Dec. 8th

Weather fine took rafflesia and pills is gone under 3 P.M. nothing else of account happened.
