Lat. 11.49 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se. on started tack.
Long. 87.14 W Last part same made a new bucket.

Lat. 11.52 S Tuesday Jan 26th

Long. 87.54 W Weather fine moderate breeze from se. on started tack.
took in light sail at sundown. Last part same nothing sight.

Wednesday Jan 27th

Lat. 11.55 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se. Clear. Last part
Long. 88.43 W same nothing of moment occurred.

Thursday Jan 28th

Lat. 11.52 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se. running free at 10
Long. 88.51 W gained Bh. Catalpa. Capt. Price. right from Port. 4.50 the ship
Last part same on the wind on Port tack Bh. Catalpa to
leeward.

Friday Jan 29th

Lat. 11.28 S Weather fine at 10 tack ship wind se. Catalpa went
Long. 89.10 W out of sight on Starboard. Last part same tack ship
at daylight. passed Catalpa on Port tack.

Saturday Jan 30th

Lat. 10.58 S Weather fine wind fresh from se at sundown tack ship
Long. 88.17 W standing to east. Last part same nothing sight.

Sunday Jan 31st

Lat. 10.41 S Weather fine with fresh breeze from se on started tack
Long. 87.31 W saw the Catalpa to leeward on Port tack. Last part same

Monday Feb. 1st

Lat. 11.07 S Weather fine fresh breeze from se on started tack
Long. 87.08 W saw a school of black fish at sundown. Last part same
Painting water ways.

Tuesday Feb. 2nd / 1869.

Lat. 11.04 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se gained the Bh.
Long. 87.09 W Falcon. she had gained with several vessels had not seen
any thing in the sea yet. Last part same on Port tack.

Wednesday Feb. 3rd

Lat. 11.05 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se. at sundown tack
Long. 88.30 W ship. Last part cloudy strong breeze from se. on sail in
sight.

Thursday Feb. 4th

Lat. 11.40 S Weather Cloudy strong breeze from se. on East. on tack.
Long. 89.30 W gained the Bh. Thos. & Edward. Capt. Cas. Clear. Last part
same (B. Edwards went only sight on started tack. or on started tack.

Friday Feb. 5th

Observation. Weather rough strong breeze from. e. se. at sundown tack
ship. on sail in sight. (had seen another vessel running from the
afternoon on Port tack.) gained the Piscadora at 9 Am. 4.70 all told.

Saturday Feb. 6th

Weather Cloudy strong breeze from se. heavy sea running gained
Piscadora & Andrew Hick. Capt. Hamilton 500 sps. Last part
same weather moderately.

Sunday Feb. 7th

Observation. Weather cloudy fresh breeze from se. gained with the
Andrew Hick. "Melina". Piscadora. Sea Ranges. Late on
home 700 sps. Last part fine moderate breeze from se.
gained with the Piscadora & Sea Ranges.

Monday Feb. 8

Lat. 11.05 S Weather fine moderate breeze from se. running quiet.
Long. 89.30 W gaining at 8 a.m. Last part same. 5 miles in sight.
