Lat 33.23 First part fine moderate breeze from E. heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Friday Feb. 26th

Lat 34.37 First part fine moderate breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Saturday Feb. 27th

Lat 35.26 First part fine moderate breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same moderate breeze from NE heading SE.

Sunday Feb. 28th

Lat 35.46 First part fine moderate breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Monday March 1st / 1869.

Lat 36.22 Commences with pleasant weather light breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same.

Tuesday March 2^d

Lat 36.88 Commences pleasant light air from NE heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Wednesday March 3^d

Lat 36.30 Commences pleasant with light air from NE heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Thursday March 4th

Lat 36.25 Commences fine with moderate breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same & toward dawn 54 lbs of oil in main hatch.

Friday Mar. 5th

Lat 36.12 Commences fine with the fresh breeze from NE heading SE. Last part same steering ENE.

Saturday March 6th / 1869.

Lat 36.10 Commences fine weather fresh breeze from NW steering ENE. Last part foggy weather with hauling around to the SE.

Sunday March 7th

Lat 36.00 Commences with foggy weather fresh breeze from SE heading ENE. Last part calm.

Monday Mar. 8th

Lat 35.48 Commences moderate breeze from NW rain in squalls. Last part calm.

Tuesday Mar. 9th

Lat 36.50 Commences cloudy strong breeze from SE steering ENE. Last part squally with SE wind.

Wednesday Mar. 10th

Lat 35.54 Commences squally strong breeze from SE steering ENE. Last part gale of wind from SE heading ENE.

Thursday Mar. 11th

Lat 35.27 Commences gale of wind from SE under close reef main & top sail. Last part same.

Friday Mar. 12th

Lat 35.34 Commences gale of wind from SE at sundown were ship weather moderating. Last part pleasant strong breeze a number of fowls in sight.

Saturday Mar. 13th

Lat 35.35 Commences cloudy strong breeze from SE. At sundown double reefed fore and main. Last part same with SE wind.

Sunday Mar. 14th

Weather fine moderate breeze from SE on Barbours tow Cape Carraige. distant 45 miles. Gained Chesapeake Bay mouth and got all the anchorage in sight. At evening
