

Lat 35. 35 S. Longitude 75. 22 W. Monday April 12th / 1868.
Commence. (only though pleasant weather) from SSW. at sundown shortened sail on Starboard tack. Last part same. making corp. mending topsail &c.

Lat 35. 23 S. Longitude 75. 05 W. Tuesday April 13th.
Commence. Pleasant weather light winds from SSW. at sundown shortened sail. Last part same. Talcen in sight. Lowered for Finback. Comed on but did not get him.

Lat 35. 40 S. Longitude 74. 42 W. Wednesday April 14th.
Commence. (only though pleasant) lowered for blackfin without success. light air from SSW. at sundown shortened sail to (1/2). Last part same. & lowered sail which was deck 3/4.

Lat 35. 58 S. Longitude 74. 01 W. Thursday April 15th.
Commence. fine weather light air from SSW. at sundown shortened sail 2 sails to windward on the Talcen running. Last part low wind hauled around to SWE. steering ESE. & sail in sight.

Lat 35. 45 S. Longitude 73. 05 W. Friday April 16th.
Commence. (only) fresh breeze from NW. on Port tack. but by N. gained Talcen & Rose Capt. Highland 2 days from Talcahuano. 95 lbs. Last part 1/2 gale from N. made land at 10 Am.

Saturday April 17th.
Commence. (only) heavy sky from N. at 3 anchored at Talcahuano. 3 American men-of-war lying here and whalers to see to mention, received 2 letters from home.

Sunday April 18th.
Pleasant weather Harbor watch went ashore on liberty. 8 from ship.

Monday April 19th.
Pleasant weather. breaking out cash for water. Paid for 2nd raft ashore.

Tuesday April 20th.
Pleasant weather. got off raft of water and stored it down.

Wednesday April 21th.
Letting up shooks 117 to 36 and sent raft ashore also taken board some of our flour. Steam Tugget Bowditch of Dundee and left this port. Weather Pleasant.

Thursday April 22th.
Weather Pleasant. showing down water. Putting ship to.

Friday April 23th.
Weather Pleasant. Putting ship getting off flour 2200 sacks the "Courier" Hambley 60 lbs since leaving 3/4.

Saturday April 24th.
Weather Pleasant. Putting ship Port watch ashore on liberty. Mail steamer arrived and left with mail.

Sunday April 25th.
Weather Pleasant. Harbor watch had liberty. Sent to Capt. H. Draper 800 from ship.

Monday April 26th.
Weather Pleasant. Port watch ashore on liberty. Dr. Maria arrived 200 lbs. Humphreys.

Tuesday April 27th.
Weather Pleasant. broke out 100 lbs. oil, coopers & Becked it.

Wednesday April 28th.
Weather Pleasant. broke out 40 lbs. oil, coopers & Becked it. 1st splendid sails.

Thursday April 29th.
Weather Pleasant. waiting for "Courier" to take our oil. "Gray Hawk" & "Hul" Morgan sailed.
