

Friday June 25th 1869.


Comencas. Cloudy weather strong trade from S.W. came to anchor 10 fathoms at 2.30 P.M. Last part same at daylight got underway bound for whale S.B. struck large Co. which ran 16 miles off shore sank and lost him the hull sank saying that he had a 34 in. Cask.

Saturday June 26th


Strong breeze and cloudy weather at 7 came to anchor in 10 fathoms off Town. Last part same Capt. went ashore at 9.00. Weather was laying at anchor.

Sunday June 27th


Cloudy fresh trade S.W. anchored off Town. Last part fine weather got underway at daylight. and stood off shore covered at 7 that struck & parted but stood in chase Capt. struck & ran off shore Parted at 4 P.M.

Monday June 28th


Weather fine came to anchor at dark mended 2 boats got underway and came to anchor again at 11 M.

Tuesday June 29th


Weather squally got underway at daylight to cruise "Fort" got a whale.

Wednesday June 30th


Fine weather came to anchor at 3.30 P.M. Last part cruising without success. Beluck & drawn.

Thursday July 1st


Fine weather light trade. anchored at 4.30 got underway at daylight to cruise. Last struck large bull off 10 Am. in shore. took him along side.

Friday July 2nd

Pleasant strong trade cut in whale. and stood in to anchor. Last part Cloudy trying out at anchor.

Saturday July 3rd 1869


Pleasant strong trade anchored off Garden Place. finished trying out. Last part at 10 P.M. turned up 4.30. got underway at daylight to cruise. Ragged weather Capt. struck and drawn.

Sunday July 4th


Weather cloudy strong breeze. Landed the Sh. (Port) Last part pleasant. Capt. struck whale from drawn after being fast 3 hours.

Monday July 5th

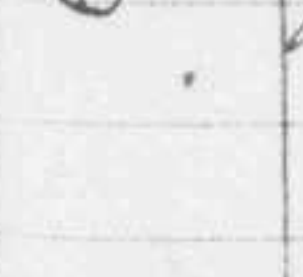

Weather fine anchored off Tiger Island in 4 fathoms at 6 P.M. at daylight took anchor to cruise Capt. struck whale and drew back.

Tuesday July 6th


Weather rough, anchored at 4 P.M. off land banks. Port came to anchor cloudy. Schooner lost anchorage. Last part got underway at daylight with strong breeze. parted anchor. stuck last boat anchor.

Wednesday July 7th


Weather pleasant strong trade came to anchor at shore the (Chas. Edwards) was anchored there at 4 P.M. Bk. Bohio arrived and came to anchor close to us. had nothing since we arrived within before. Last part light winds at daylight took anchor to cruise raised wind Capt. struck Co. at 12.30 took to anchor and took hauly net finished cutting at 11.

Thursday July 8th


Weather fine cutting blue into horse pie. Last part same two boats cruising in shore.

Friday July 9th


Comencas fine started work at 1 P.M. anchored off Tiger Island. Last part same finished trying out at 10 P.M. turned up 4.30. Boat cruising in shore.
