Weather fine, calm, entered at 5 P.M. also Pedro, son, & by, with tobacco etc. Last part same got under my chased cow and calf without success, stood down the coast

Friday Aug. 27th

Mea then dugged canoe to anchor in $2\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms on the bank
of Emeralds. She has her in 2 fms. ran out long dip
and canoe ship out into 10 fathoms morning sent rap
up river for water.

Saturday Aug. 28th

Weather fine, mended fly pit, and got hole ready for water.
Suet, had same got off our water & cleaned it.

Sunda, Aug. 29th

Weather fine received letter from Wife dated 20th May.
Last part same Mr Lewis & myself went up to the tower to
see the sight.

Monday Aug 30th

Weather fine, lowered for cow calf in the mouth of Conemaugh river without success. Last had some smoldering, both said and up one and started the other.

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Tuesday, Aug. 31st.

Nothing of moment occurred. Last night same
steamer from Panama arrived took 21 pack of Bread & Flour for
the B.S.

Wednesday Sept 1st

Weather fine. Casper's Bread & Flour and Flour is down.
Lard had same. put some bread ashore sent Lettuce ashore.

Tuesday Sept 29

Weather fine lowered for Humphreys State School
J. M. Anderson, took her silver pens, came to anchor again.
A gentleman on board from Emerald Isle, came.
Cut in whale first ^{to capture} at Emeralds.

Frida, Sep. 3rd

Weather fine commenced trying out at 2 Pm. Last part same
finished trying out at 11 Am. Call returned at 11.

Saturday Sept 4

With the fine nothing of account happened. Last part same
of Sunday at day light. Getting up to soon.

Sunday Sept. 5th

Weather fine, strong breeze at 4 came to anchor at Loose
Last part same water lowered for whale or that success
Capt ashore

Monday Sept 6th

Wrote Lin at 5 Pm Schooner Mary, C. Mason (Sparks) &
Bk. A. B. Cook arrived and anchored saw W. Cornell.
Last/first fire storing down oil.

Tuesday, Sept. 17!!

Weather fair finishie steaming down, gained Schoon
or Brig. in the evening. ~~Sat~~ ^{Sun} ~~had~~ ^{came} ~~gt~~ ^{gt} under way at 7 A.M.
stood out to sea under all sail, making Ancho clock.
