Comences fine light wind at sundown light squalls of rain, cloudy, one sail in sight wore ship and took in light sail. Last part same Cruising.

Friday Sept 24th

Comences fine moderate breeze on Starboard tack. Last part same repairing boat on the lower

Saturday Sept 25th

Comences fine moderate breeze from S.W. on sail in sight on Port weather, one ship at sundown. Last part same one sail passed us to windward on Port tack.

Sunday Sept 26th

Comences fine at sundown one ship to Starboard tack. Last part same 2 sails in sight running off on Port tack saw 3 school of Blackfish.

Monday Sept 27th

Lat 50° N Comences fine strong breeze against Ana. Rosa. (Lat 50.40 N) Molten. 550 B. on Port tack. Last part same. Black fish in sight, repairing boat.

Tuesday Sept 28th

Comences fine moderate breeze on Starboard tack. Last part same lowered for Blackfish without success on Port.

Wednesday Sept 29th

Comences fine moderate breeze from S.W. on Port tack. Last part same.

Thursday Sept 30th

1 1/2 H.

2 H.

Comences fine lowered for Blackfish 50.50 N 2 Last part put up fore Capt Blacksmith's barrel out Blackfish 1 1/2 H.

Friday Oct 1st

Comences fine weather light breeze caught trawler employed in Blacksmithing. Last part same passed a Grecian merchantman at m.

Saturday Oct 2nd

Comences fine moderate breeze Cruising. Last part same strong breeze.

Sunday Oct 3rd

Comences strong breeze & squally. Cruising Last part same nothing in sight.

Monday Oct 4th

Comences squally with rain. Cruising Last part fine light wind 3 sails in sight on Starboard tack.

Tuesday Oct 5th

50.40 N

81.36 W

Comences fine with light breeze from S.W. on Starboard tack. Last part same on Port tack, saw Blackfish.

Wednesday Oct 6th

50.00 N

80.00 W

Comences fine with light wind from S.W. at sundown came broad on Starboard tack took in light sail. Last part same land in sight running off to W. came to wind on Port tack, out sight of land at m.

Thursday Oct 7th

50.00 N

81.57 W

Comences fine moderate breeze from S.W. Port tack. Last part same for a while in sight running off to W.
