Lat 1° 25' N. Commences fine weather light breeze on Starboard tack
 Long 82° 50' W. Last part same number of finbacks in sight on
 Port tack fresh breeze

Sunday Oct 24th

Lat 1° 18' N. Commences fine with fresh breeze from S. E. at
 Long 82° 35' W. sundown tacked ship to Starboard tack under
 short sail. Last part same strong breeze.

Monday Oct 25th

Commences Cloudy strong breeze quite ruffled. Last
 part same steering East.

Galapagos

Tuesday Oct 26th

Commences Cloudy strong S. W. breeze sundown tacked
 to windward took in light sail. Last part same 24th
 Point Galapagos at 11 Am steering N at 11.

Wednesday Oct 27th

Commences fine weather shifted to windward on Port
 tack at 3 Pm. Last part same on the wind on Port
 tack

Thursday Oct 28th

Commences fine weather strong breeze from S. E. at
 W 1/2 N. Port tack last part same with moderate breeze
 mending S. E. but Port "new"

Friday Oct 29th

Commences fine weather moderate breeze was shifted
 to Starboard tack. Last part Cloudy strong breeze
 employed as yesterday

Saturday Oct 30th

Lat 1° 50' N. Commences Cloudy strong wind with occasional
 squalls of rain, tack to Port at sundown.
 Last part same fresh mending S. E. Port.
 one sail on the quarter

Sunday Oct 31st 1827

Commences Cloudy strong breeze from S. E. Starboard tack
 54 W. 2 sails gaining to leeward, occasional small light
 rain. Parting S. E. Port. Last part same & tacking
 to W 1/2 N under short sail

Monday Nov 1st

Commences Cloudy strong breeze & tacking to W 1/2 N
 under short sail. Last part same tacked at 7 Am
 steering to E 1/2 S

Tuesday Nov 2nd

Commences pleasant moderate breeze from S. E.
 tacked at sundown heading to W 1/2 N. Last part same.
 Running

Wednesday Nov 3rd

Commences Cloudy though pleasant weather moderate breeze
 from S. E. at 12 M. Anna Rosa, hauled down 60 lbs since
 we last saw her. Last part same "A-Rosa" on Port bow
 windward

Thursday Nov 4th

Commences foggy weather strong breeze from S. E. at 12 M.
 (began forward) raised sperm whales ahead at 2 Pm.
 40 N. going to windward lowered boats at 4 Pm. to cut off
 W. whales without success. Boats chased until dark.
 Whales going S. W. Last part ruffled Cloudy weather
 working to windward

Friday Nov 5th

Lat 2° 28' N. Commences Cloudy strong breeze S. E. on Port tack.
 at 4 Pm. raised beach 4 points on weather. low sea no more
 of it up to dark. Last part same tacking to windward.

Saturday Nov 6th

Commences strong wind & Cloudy on Starboard tack at
 sundown took in main & fore sails. Last part same
 at A moderate breeze hazy.
