

Sunday Nov. 8th 1867.

Lat 1, 20 N. (Cameces, cloudy weather, light breeze from S. by E. at sundown tacked to Port, hauled up courses. Last part fine weather, light breeze from S. by E. nothing in sight.

Monday, Nov. 9th 1867

Cameces fine weather, light wind from S. by E. at sundown took in light sail and tacked to Starboard. Last part same. Cruise.

Tuesday Nov. 9th

Fine weather, light breeze from S. by E. on Starboard tack. Last part same. Raised sail at M. on the low 4 point. on Starboard tack we were on Port tack.

Wednesday Nov. 10th

Fine weather, light breeze from S. by E. M. B. to the west. men off. 2 boats down we lowered 3 boats which ran down to her. proved to be Ph. Ana Rosa, a schooner seen at going to M. E. did not know whether it was Spanish or was seen no more after our boats got there. boats returned to ship at 6.30 Pm. Last part fine weather steering N. by E.

Thursday, Nov. 11th

Lat 1, 00 N. Slightly weather, fresh breeze from S. by E. at sundown came to on Port tack, took in light sail. Last part same. Strong breeze squally.

Friday Nov. 12th

Strong breeze & squally weather on Port tack steering to W. by N. Last part same as day, light S. by E. Port quarter, on the other tack fine, with.

Saturday Nov. 13th

Fine weather, moderate breeze S. by E. tacked ship at 1.30 Pm. for fine back beach on weather quite. Last part squally.

Sunday, Nov. 14th

Squally weather, moderate breeze with occasional squalls. of fine rain on Port tack. Last part fine weather plenty of birds & fish but no whales, my birthday.

Monday, Nov. 15th

Lat 1, 20 N. (Cameces, fine moderate breeze at sundown (Cloudy, took in light sail on Starboard tack. Last part same as courses on same tack.

Tuesday, Nov. 16th

30 N. Cloudy strong breeze from S. by E. on Starboard tack heading S. by E. at sundown took in light sail. Last part same steering E.

Wednesday Nov. 17th

Cloudy strong breeze S. by E. at sundown took in courses and luffed to wind Starboard tack, shot a Merganser hawk. Last part on the wind Starboard tack fine weather quite cool.

Thursday 18th

Lat 1, 20 N. (Cameces fine fresh breeze S. by E. Starboard tack heading S. by E. at sundown took in courses Last part same. Course for Blackfish without success.

Friday 19th

Cameces fine moderate breeze from S. by E. on Starboard tack under shortened sail. Last part same all sail out. B. with still wait to windward sighted Ple of Plat.

Saturday, 20th

Cameces fine moderate breeze lowered 4 boats for Blackfish captured 5 L. B. 2, B. 2, W. 1, B. 1, at sundown within 3/4 mile of Ple of Plat. were ship, one sail turned. Last part same by wind. Blackfish 4 B. tacked in the land in sight.
