

Thursday Jan 20th 1870.

Lat 5^o 45' S Commences fine weather fresh breeze from S.E. on the tack. Last part equally with rain. gamed the Sh. Platina Chan. 1040 H. all day.

Friday Jan 21st

Commences strong wind with occasional squalls of rain gamed Platina until 8^o P.M. Last part fine weather. 2 sails in sight.

Saturday Jan 22nd

Lat 5 14 S Commences fine moderate breeze at sun down one sail ahead. took 2 more shovs from ship chert. Last part same. 2 sails in sight one on each side standing to S^o. At 10^o of night at 11 P.M. raised sail ahead running off. supposed to wind on Pt. St. Jago towards the Sultan.

Sunday Jan 23rd

Commences fine weather fresh breeze from S.E. named the Sultan. she had taken 100 lbs silver having touched reports Amalda. taking large whale 2 sp. this morn. she saw whales (large lot) the 1st of 2000 lb weight. Last part same (Sultan in sight) running off to seaward and of sight at 11. in Sultan's bay.

Monday Jan 24th

Commences fine weather fresh breeze from S.E. on Start on tack. Last part same picking from sail nothing in sight.

Tuesday Jan 25th

Lat 5 00 S Commences fine moderate breeze from E^o Cruising. Last part same clearing air with and painting it with red list.

Wednesday Jan 26th

Commences fine moderate breeze from E^o Cruising nothing in sight. Last part same.

Thursday Jan 27th 1870

Commences fine with strong E^o wind Cruising. Last part same 2 Bl. & 1 schooner in sight.

Friday Jan 28th

Commences strong breeze from S.E. gamed Platina. also first of the War Hyd. 60 lbs this evening. Last part same 2 sails in sight.

Saturday Jan 29th

Lat 4 40 S Commences squall wind S.E. Cruising nothing in sight. At sundown. Last part same first of War Hyd. passed Platina in sight in the morning.

Sunday Jan 30th

Lat 4 50 S Commences pleasant strong wind Cruising on 104 30 W in sight. Last part same caught Pehoa.

Monday Jan 31st

Commences fine strong breeze from E^o Cruising gamed 'D' Edward had run nothing since last spoken. Last part same 2 sails in sight.

Feb 1st

Tuesday Feb 1st 1870.

Lat 5 20 S Commences fine strong breeze on sail in sight. Sultan's boat (large) raised whale on log. Last part at 3 45 saw 3 boats struck at 5 P.M. (D.B.) turned him up seaward kept him along side at dark. Last part fine had body of whale in at 11. one sail passed towards west.

Wednesday Feb 2nd

Commences fine strong breeze from E^o took in head scow. dikes cleared at 6 15 P.M. commenced boiling at 8 30 P.M. Last part fine light wind on sail in sight.
