

Tuesday Mar. 8th 1870.

Lat 4. 44 S
Long 109. 15 W
Comences fine weather moderate breeze from ESE on Port tack Sebastian (SW) raised whales at 5.30 P.M. 5 miles off. going toward shore. sun until dark and hauled aboard main yard, finished boiling at 2 Am. Last part same. mended munciey machine. whale lard up 30 lbs.

Wednesday Mar. 9th

Lat 4. 44 S
Long 109. 45 W
Comences fine light breeze from S. crewing ship started mending of foretacks in night. Last part same strong breeze from ESE and new fly jib. & Main topsail

Thursday Mar. 10th

Lat 4. 30 S
Long 110. 23 W
Comences strong breeze and pleasant weather on Port tack heading south, last part 2 strong breeze and squalls.

Friday Mar. 11th

Lat 4. 54 S
Long 111. 58 W
Comences strong breeze & usually from the ESE. on Starboard tack heading to SE. Last part fine running ESE.

Saturday Mar. 12th

Lat 4. 35 S
Long 108. 47 W
Comences fine light breeze from ESE tack to Starboard at sundown. Squall of rain at 7 P.M. Last part same saw Black fish & porpoises.

Sunday Mar. 13th

Lat 4. 40 S
Long 111. 15 W
Comences pleasant strong breeze from ESE. crewing ship. Last part Cloudy strong breeze from SE foretack and foremast in sight.

Monday Mar. 14th

Lat 3. 50 S
Long 110. 55 W
Comences Cloudy strong breeze from SE on Starboard tack. Last part same calm tack

Tuesday Mar. 15th

Lat 3. 41 S
Long 109. 50 W
Comences Cloudy strong breeze with occasional heavy squalls, from SE. on ESE tack. Last part same.

Wednesday Mar. 16th 1870.

Lat 2. 24 S
Long 108. 34 W
Comences changeable wind, rains in squalls, on ESE tack wind SE. Last part fine weather moderate breeze repaired water cask.

Thursday March 17th

Lat 1. 00 S
Long 107. 23 W
Comences fine weather fresh breeze from SE on Starboard tack. Last part same mending foremast. Calm saw Black fish.

Friday March 18th

Lat 0. 32 S
Long 107. 28 W
Comences fine weather light air from SE Starboard tack. Last part same repairing sails ship heading ENE.

Saturday Mar. 19th

Lat 0. 10 S
Long 107. 12 W
Comences fine light breeze from SE crew ship heading ENE. employed in mending sail. Last part same lowered for Blackfish without success. repaired cask.

Sunday Mar. 20th

Lat 0. 00
Long 106. 43 W
Comences fine light breeze from SE. Starboard tack. Last part same calm weather. Cut & killed shark

Monday Mar. 21st

Comences fine weather calm lowered for Blackfish without success. Last part same light air from ESE. on Starboard tack raised whales at 11 Am. lowered 4 boats chased with oars. whales going ESE

Tuesday Mar. 22nd

Lat 0. 20 N
Long 106. 20 W
Light air from ESE. 3rd mate struck at 2.45 P.M. 2nd mate chased school and struck at 4.30 P.M. took first whale along side at 5.30 P.M. 2nd at 8 P.M. Last run of school 4 boats weather bow going to North. Last part same had whales cut in at 9.30 Am ship on Port tack through the night. backed at 11 Am.
