

Sunday April 24th 1870.

Lat 5.10 N. Commence stormy wind fresh from the S. at 7 P.M. thunder & lightning, & plenty of fresh water. Last part same steering SSE & SE. most of the time to m.

Monday April 25th

Lat 4.30 N. Commence stormy strong breeze from S.W. heading ESE. Last part rugged. wind SSE. passed 6 turtle today.

Tuesday April 26th

Lat 4.20 N. Commence Cloudy strong breeze from SSE heading sent down for the Gallant sail repaired it & sent it up again. Last part same repaired Main Gallant sail.

Wednesday April 27th

Lat 3.25 N. Commence pleasant weather, strong breeze from SSE heading E. Last part same fresh breeze from S. heading ESE. (Commenced same)

Thursday April 28th

Lat 2.40 N. Commence pleasant, moderate breeze from S. heading ESE (number of turtle in water). Last part same lashed at 7 A.M. heading S.W. by W.

Friday April 29th

Lat 2.03 N. Commence pleasant, moderate breeze from SSE. lashed at 4 o'clock P.M. heading ESE employed in ship's duty (rattling down foremast). Last part same light breeze from S. heading ESE.

Saturday April 30th

Lat 1.42 N. Commence pleasant with light air from S. heading ESE. Last part same with moderate breeze. Cutting plankenies, truck & sand boxes.

Sunday May 1st 1870.

Commence fine weather. Captured 2 turpids. Lat 1.14 N. Last part same steering SE. Porpoise in sight. Lat 2.20 W.

Monday May 2nd

Lat 2.58 N. Commence fine weather, light breeze from S. heading ESE. Last part same employed in ship duty. Lat 3.06 W.

Tuesday May 3rd

Commence fine weather, light breeze from S. heading ESE. Last part Cloudy, wind same. Land in sight at daylight. Port Francisco at 11.30 anchored in Spur. off Tiger Island, 4 1/2 fathoms by port anchor. One sail in sight (Chiron).

Wednesday May 4th

Rain in squalls, anchored at four sent down sails at main & took in Pil boom to repair. Last part fine weather 29 Mate ashore cutting left mast employed in making Pil boom.

Thursday May 5th

Commence fine party ashore making topmast bands on board sending out Pil boom & Rigger is sending down main topmast & La.

Friday May 6th

Fine weather Employed in setting off topmast, &c. Capt. & For. went to Amarel's.

Saturday May 7th

Fine weather Employed in making topmast.

Sunday May 8th

Cloudy moderate breeze from S. Martineau watch ashore running the scurvy out.
