Comences fine moderate breeze from S. ²⁰ ~~25~~ on eastern tack
R. L. Bate not far off. Last part same making tops.

Thursday 9th

Comences fine moderate breeze from S. ²⁰ ~~25~~ W. ²⁰ ~~25~~
on Starboard tack gained R. L. Bate. Last part same

Lat. 5.50 N

Friday June 10th

Comences fine weather light breeze from W. ²⁰ ~~25~~ steering
S. by E. R. L. Bate ahead. Last part strong breeze from W. ²⁰ ~~25~~
steering S. by E. gained R. L. Bate. Capt. Cole sick.

Lat. 5.40 N

Saturday June 11th

Comences Cloudy strong breeze from S. ²⁰ ~~25~~ W. ²⁰ ~~25~~ raised Golgo
ahead at 5 Pm. Came to wind Starboard land distant 20 mi.
Last part same light breeze from S. ²⁰ ~~25~~ W. ²⁰ ~~25~~

Sunday June 12th

Comences fine fresh breeze from W. ²⁰ ~~25~~ at 5 Pm. came to
anchor at Golgo. in 14 fathoms. raised to 60 fathoms cable
R. L. Bate also this anchored. Last part same. Capt.
still sick also 3rd mate.

Monday June 13th

Comences Cloudy strong trade breeze ashore. taking a
bump. Last part same rain in the fore noon. at 9
Pm. heaved cast for water and comenced setting up
shocks. sent raft ashore.

Tuesday June 14th

Comences fine weather light breeze. setting up shocks
cutting wood &c. saw humpback close in shore

Wednesday June 15th

Rained most of the morning & calm. the rest of cal. at
shocks got 30 cask water one load wood.

Thursday June 16th

Weather fine blowing water & wood finished
at 5 Pm.

Friday June 17th

Weather stormy light and getting on board oranges
S. by E. R. L. Bate left at 3:30 Pm. Merchant schooner arrived
and anchored (Capt. better)

Saturday June 18th

Weather stormy in the morning. took on board 6000 oranges
Merchant schooner left for Pagan.

Sunday June 19th

Weather fine with moderate breeze morning while boarded
ashore to see the Capt. struck a humpback towed him
along side had him cut in at 9 Pm.

Monday June 20th

Weather fine until 7 Pm. Boiling Capt. better
raining hard through the night (had awning up)

Tuesday June 21st

Comences pleasant Capt. came on board
at 8 Am. Boiling number 4 H. Back in 24
finished at 2 Pm. turned up 79

Wednesday June 22nd

Stormy in the morning comencing 2 boats rather heavy

Thursday June 23rd

fine weather dry in fore. S. B. struck cow hump
back and started him.

Friday June 24

Weather stormy in the morning cleared off
at 10 lowered 2 boats to cruise without success

Island Golgo.
