Saturday Sept. 10th 1870.

Comences strong trade & Cloud weather on Port tack heading WNW. Last part same

Lat. 24° 50' N
Long. 88° 00' W

Sunday Sept. 11th

Comences strong trade & Cloudy heading SW on Port tack. Last part same game. Old Mary Fulcahuano Capt. Kelly. (C. H. Miller)

Lat. 29° 19' W

Monday Sept. 12th

Comences fine weather strong trade Port tack heading WSW. Last part equally. (Mary ahead.)

Tuesday Sept. 13th

Cloudy with strong trade. Tacked ship at sundown. Mary astern. At 7 AM came around to Port tack fine weather nothing in sight.

Lat. 37° N

Wednesday Sept. 14th

Comences fine weather by 2 breezes raised land at 4 PM 2 points leeward (Menman Island) tacked at sundown sail to leeward. Last part same tacked to Starboard at 7 AM Mary in sight.

Thursday Sept. 15th

Comences fine weather game. "Mary" Abington Island in sight 2 points on weather. New ship heading SE. Last part same one sail to leeward.

Friday Sept. 16th

Comences fine weather light breezes Abington bearing E. dist 15 miles. Last part same with strong trade & weather current of Rock Rockensis 2 boats attempted to pick up the crew but it was too rough.

Saturday Sept. 17th 1870.

30° 45' N

Comences strong winds game. "Anelupa" Hick Gray Hound. Mary... 9 sails in sight about the Rock. At Hart met A. Wick (Funky Dory) refused me to. The Collock, cooper at N. Bedford. should get home before him. Last part pleasant with light winds.

Harbours. 1000 ft.

Sunday Sept. 18th

Comences fine weather light breeze from SSE & gaming "Pescadora" (Stapton) (Pescadora) & Mary. Kelly of Harbours. Island. Last part same

N. Head. 1000 ft.

Monday Sept. 19th

Comences fine weather light breeze 6 sail in sight. Cruising between Rock & Harbours. saw Ana Raa. to leeward at 5 PM with 2 boats. Down. Last part same game Virginia Marks. & Pescadora. saw John Wilcox, cooper.

Tuesday Sept. 20th

Fine weather gaming about vessel also Bihie 30 lbs. since leaving Esmeraldas off the Rock. Last part Cloudy with 2 very heavy from SSE & sail in sight.

Wednesday Sept. 21st

Comences squally game. Scho. M. E. Mason. she had letters from Esmeraldas, also Rind & Catalpa. to windward of Rock trying sail at sundown heading off shore. Last part rugged made sail at daylight and left for off shore

Lat. 22° 35' W

Thursday Sept. 22nd

Cloudy strong breeze from SSE on Port tack heading SW Last part same saw a dog fin back
