and lowered three boats and each got one hauler them in on deck and then got supper Middle part the watch employed leaving the blubber Latter part employed menceing it the weather is squally with some rain saw nothing so ends this day

Sunday 26th

Commence today with a light breeze from the S. W. vessel by the wind heading S. with rain squalls crew employed at nothing for it is the day of rest the sailor loosing day saw porpoises and struck one Middle and Latter part the wind from all directions with rain squalls saw Black fish and lowered two boats but did not get near enough to strike the 3rd boat struck and otherine from off the bow of the vessel the line parted and away he went iron and all also saw conch fish porpoises and one fin back so ends this day

Monday 27th

Commence today with rain squalls wind and rain from every directions vessel first on the wind and then before it and at times no wind at all Middle part very light winds from different quarters her course is S. by W. Latter part wind and weather the same saw Black fish but did not lower because we were trying out the Black fish bubble we took on a Saturday also saw porpoises that is all so ends this day

Tuesday 28th

Commence today with a light breeze from the S. W. vessel by the wind heading W. by S. crew employed on ship's duty one sail in sight heading to the Eastward Middle

part a dead calm Latter part light winds from the S. vessel steering S. W. with fine pleasant weather saw porpoises so ends this day

Wednesday 29th

Commence today with a light breeze from the S. with fine pleasant weather vessel steering S. W. crew employed breaking but the fore hole two sails in sight Middle part wind and weather the same Latter part wind from the N. E. nothing in sight so ends this day

Thursday 30th

Commence today with a light breeze from the S. with rain squalls vessel by the wind heading S. W. by S. crew employed on various parts ship's duty at sundown took in sail for the night we have arrived on the Cornhill ground and intend to cruise here for a few days Middle & Latter part wind and weather the same saw porpoises and nothing more so ends this day

Friday 31st

Commence today with a light breeze from the S. W. with fine pleasant weather vessel by the wind heading W. by S. crew employed on ship's duty at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter part light winds from different quarters with rain squalls saw a water spout this morning about 2 miles to windward no more for today so ends

Saturday 1st of November

Commence today with a moderate breeze from the S. vessel steering W. by S. crew employed on ship's duty saw porpoises and struck two at sundown took the light sail for the night but kept her the same
