

Remarks on Board Barque

Thursday 4th

Commenced today with a light breeze from the S. E. vessel laying aback cutting in at sundown stopped cutting and got the works ready to start boiling Middle part wind and weather the same at 7 o'clock P.M. started the works and commenced boiling latter part at daylight commenced cutting again so ends this day

Friday 5th

Commenced today with a light breeze from the S. E. vessel still laying aback finished cutting at 12 o'clock P.M. bailed the Case and got it over board and cleared up the decks for the night Middle and latter part a strong breeze from the S. E. still boiling one sail in sight so ends this day

Saturday 6th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind crew employed working on the blubber we are still boiling but all ready for another whale if we can get one Middle part wind the same latter part at 7 o'clock P.M. finished boiling and cleared up the decks washed off and then got stender so ends this day

Sunday 7th

Commenced today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind on the Starboard tack crew employed on ship's duty at sundown took in sail for the night and set boat's crew watches today William Crosby took down the box of Tobacco he sold 250 in gold, the whale making between 30 and 60 barrels sold the Tobacco to the Captain for nine dollars in gold Middle part wind and

weather the same called all hands at daylight and cleaned the Trupworks latter part a strong breeze from the same quarter saw one sail so ends this day

Monday 8th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind on the Starboard tack one sail in sight at sundown took in sail for the night and set the same watches as the night before Middle and latter part wind and weather the same at daylight called all hands got up the tackles and went to work stowing down oil so ends this day

Tuesday 9th

Commenced today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind employed stowing down oil at 6 o'clock P.M. finished stowing down set the same watches as the night before Middle and latter part wind and weather the same saw one sail so ends this day

Wednesday 10th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind on different tacks crew employed washing their oil clothes saw a brig steering to the Southward at sundown took in sail for the night and stood sea watches Middle and latter part wind and weather the same saw nothing so ends this day

Thursday 11th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind cruising on different tacks crew employed on ship's duty at sundown took in sail for the night Middle
