Commenced today with a strong breeze
from the N.E. vessel starting
at 10 A.M. crew employed on ship's
duty saw two sails today at sun-
down look in sail for the night and looked
to the wind Middle and Latter parts
a very strong breeze from the North
with quite a sea running saw nothing
so ends this day

Saturday 13th

Commenced today with a very strong
breeze from the N.E. vessel by the
wind cruising for whales crew
employed on ship's duty Middle and
Latter parts strong winds from the
same quarter saw two sails so ends
this day

Sunday 14th

Commenced today with a strong breeze
from North vessel by the wind
cruising on different tack saw a
steamer heading towards the S.W.
bound around Cape Horn Espouse
at sundown look in the pit and
reset the main topsail over again
the weather growing more moderate
Middle and Latter parts a moderate
breeze from the same quarter saw two
sails so ends this day

Monday 15th

Commenced today with a moderate
breeze from the N. vessel by the wind
cruising on different tack crew
employed on ship's duty Middle and
Latter parts much rain with variable
winds at daylight set the top sails
and courses light and gaff topsail
saw pinbacks blacking nothing more so
ends this day

Tuesday 16th

Commenced today with variable winds
and rain squalls vessel by the wind
cruising for whales crew employed on
ship's duty at sundown look in sail
for the night Middle and Latter
parts a steady breeze from the N.E.
vessel by the wind saw nothing so ends
this day

Wednesday 17th

Commenced today with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. vessel starting
at 10 A.M. with pleasant weather crew
employed on various parts of ship's
duty at sundown look in sail for the
night Middle part lying under
short sail at daylight hoisted all
sail and kept her S.E. saw one sail
so ends this day

Thursday 18th

Commenced today with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. vessel by the
wind cruising on different tack
crew employed making sea saw three
sails and one Billfish at sundown
look in sail for the night Middle and
Latter parts wind and weather the same
saw a large English Steamer bound to
the Southward nothing more so ends
this day

Friday 19th

Commenced today with a moderate
breeze from the N.E. vessel starting
at 10 A.M. running over the whaling
ground looking for whales crew employ-
ed on ship's duty saw one sail Middle
and Latter parts strong winds from the
N.E. saw two sails so ends this
day

Saturday 20th

Commenced today with a strong breeze
from the N.E. vessel by the wind
cruising on different tack crew employ-
ed on ship's duty saw two sails Middle
and Latter parts a light breeze from the
North saw two sails so ends this day
