Sunday 21st

Commences today with a light breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind cruising for whallem employed on ships duty and repairing the foresail off black point. Went the foresail and set it at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter parts light airs and calms saw a diamond fish and nothing more so ends this day

Monday 22nd

Commences today with light airs and calms from all points of the compass vessel by the wind crew employed on ships duty saw grampus and one sail called her a whaler but was too far off to be positive at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter parts a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind so ends this day

Tuesday 23rd

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind crew employed on ships duty and also scraping and painting the stanchions saw one sail and porpoises also struck one at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter parts strong winds from the same quarter vessel steering S. by E. saw nine sails and struck another porpoise so ends this day

Wednesday 24th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind crew employed on ships duty saw a number of sails steering to the South Middle and Latter parts a strong breeze from the same quarter vessel steering S. by E. so ends this day

Commences today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel steering S. by E. with pleasant weather crew employed on ships duty today is Christmas and I wish a merry one to all, a merry, merry, Christmas saw one sail at sundown took in sail and luffed to the wind Middle and Latter parts a moderate breeze from the same quarter vessel steering S. by E. saw nothing so ends this day

Friday 26th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. with fine pleasant weather vessel steering S. E. crew employed on ships duty at sundown took in sail for the night and luffed to the wind Middle and Latter parts wind and weather the same saw one sail so ends this day

Saturday 27th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind cruising on different tracks we have arrived on the whaling ground crew employed on ships duty today our little porpoise dog died and we buried him in the sailors grave the deep blue sea at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter parts wind and weather the same so ends this day

Sunday 28th

Commences today with a light breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind with fine pleasant weather crew employed on ships duty at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Latter parts a moderate breeze from the same quarter saw finbacks and porpoises and one sail made her out to be a whaler so ends this day
