Tuesday 3rd

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the N.E. vessel by the wind cruising on different tacks crew employed overhauling blocks traps and on ships duty at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Tatter parts a light breeze from the Eastward saw nothing so ends this day

Wednesday 4th

Commences today with a very light breeze from the E. vessel by the wind heading S. S. E. it is fine pleasant weather crew are employed on various parts of ships duty and overhauling blocks traps at sundown took in sail for the night Middle part wind the same Tatter part wind from the N. E. saw one sail so ends this day

Thursday 5th

Commences today with a light breeze from the N. E. vessel by the wind on the starboard tack crew employed on ships duty and overhauling blocks traps one sail in sight at sundown took in sail for the night Middle and Tatter parts wind from the E. N. E. saw porpoises so ends this day

Friday 6th

Commences today with a light breeze from the E. S. E. vessel by the wind on the Starboard tack with fine pleasant weather crew employed on ships duty and overhauling blocks traps at sundown swayed up the jibs but did not take in sail we are bound at north Middle and Tatter parts wind and weather the same saw killers so ends this day

Saturday 7th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the E. vessel by the wind heading S. S. E. with fine pleasant weather crew employed making fore topsail foot-tops and on ships duty Middle and Tatter parts wind and weather the same hove out the Stow Chest today and sold the crew some clothes saw nothing so ends this day

Sunday 8th

Commences today with a light breeze from the S. E. by E. vessel by the wind on the Starboard tack heading N. E. by E. with fine pleasant weather crew employed on ships duty saw two sails Middle variable winds with rain squalls Tatter part wind from the N. E. by E. saw one sail and a horn-nosed shark and that is all so ends this day

Monday 9th

Commences today with a light breeze from the N. E. by E. vessel by the wind heading N. by E. with fine pleasant weather crew employed on ships duty Middle and Tatter parts wind and weather the same saw one sail and a good many birds so ends this day

Tuesday 10th

Commences today with a light breeze from the N. E. by E. vessel by the wind on the Port tack heading E. crew employed on ships duty we are bound for the Island of Trinidad to cruise for sperm whales saw a large Billfish Middle part wind the same Tatter part light winds and sailing from all quarters with heavy rain squalls so ends this day
