

Remarks on Board Barge

Thursday 19th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind on different tack the Island was about 8 miles off at half past 12 O'clock P.M. lowered away two boats to go a fishing around the Island pulled for it till 3 O'clock and then gave it up. within two miles of the beach but we had a rough sea and a strong current against us so we turned back and got a board out sundown the Captain shot three large birds so that is all the game we got this day and latter part wind and weather the same we are bound North steering a course of N. E. by E. for the 12.40 ground saw porpoises and struck one the line parted and we lost him so ends this day Lat 18.38 Long 29.08.

Friday 20th

Commenced today with a strong breeze from the S. E. vessel steering N. by E. crew employed on different parts of ship's duty Middle and latter parts blowing a very strong breeze from the same quarter with rain squalls saw nothing so ends this day

Saturday 21st Lat 15.50 Long 29.33

Commenced today with a very strong breeze from the S. E. vessel steering a course of N. by E. with quite a sea running crew employed bending a new spanker and on ship's duty saw one sail Middle and latter parts steering N. E. by E. with a strong breeze from squalls from the same quarter saw nothing so ends this day

Commenced today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. with pleasant weather vessel steering N. by E. crew employed breaking out a barrel of Beef and on ship's duty we are in what they call the South East Trade Winds but at times they shift to or three points each way Middle and latter parts wind and weather the same so ends this day Lat 10.30 Long 29.46

Monday 23rd

Commenced today with a light breeze from the S. E. with fine pleasant weather vessel by the wind crew employed on ship's duty Middle and latter parts a moderate breeze from the S. saw a can bucket marking spike and nothing more so ends this day Lat 7.59 Long 29.44

Tuesday 24th

Commenced today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the course of steering N. E. by E. with cloudy weather looks like rain crew employed on ship's duty Middle and latter parts strong breeze from the S. E. saw three sails steering to the South so ends this day Lat 4.33 Long 29.36

Wednesday 25th

Commenced today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel steering N. E. by E. crew employed on ship's duty saw two sails Middle and latter parts wind from the S. E. vessel steering N. E. by N. half E. so ends this day
