Tuesday 3th

Commences today with a strong breeze from the W. S. W. with rain squalls vessel steering S. E. crew employed on ships duty at sundown luffed to the wind abiddell part wind shifted into the S. E. latter part a moderate breeze from the same quarter so ends this day

Wednesday 6th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. vessel by the wind cruising on different tacks crew employed on various parts of ships duty at sundown took in sail for the night abiddell & latter part wind & weather the same vessel steering E. N. E. saw a finback & nothing more so ends this day

Thursday 7th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. E. with fine weather vessel steering N. E. crew employed on ships duty at sundown took in sail for the night abiddell part by the wind & latter part steering E. E. saw nothing but porpoises so ends this day

Friday 8th

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. S. E. with fine weather vessel steering E. N. E. crew employed on ships duty saw a school of porpoises at sundown took in sail for the night abiddell part by the wind latter part steering E. N. E. one sail in sight so ends this

John Consalves raised a school of sperm whales. a merchant ship frightened them and away they went to windward we lowered two boats and gave chase but without success returned on board and down tacks and kept her by the wind abiddell part tacked ship twice latter part wind & weather the same so ends this day

W. with pleasant weather vessel by the wind cruising on different tacks crew employed on ships duty abiddell part wind and weather the same took in sail for the night latter part a strong breeze from the W. saw two finbacks beaching & whitewatering so ends this day

Commences today with a strong breeze from the W. with quite a heavy sea vessel by the wind on different tacks crew employed on ships duty saw a school of porpoises at sundown took in sail for the night abiddell and latter part wind from West & North so ends this day

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
