

Remarks on Board Barque

Saturday 13th

Commences today with a light breeze from the E. with fine weather vessel by the wind on different tacks crew employed on ships duty saw three sails & grampusses at sundown took in the light sails for the night: just before supper we picked up a large ball of tallow it filled a barrel & a half Middle & Latter part wind & weather the same so ends this day

Sunday 16th

Commences today with a light breeze from the E. S. E. vessel steering N. with fine clear pleasant weather three sails in sight crew employed on various parts of ships duty saw black fish. at 6 O'clock P.M. gammed with the Barque Cisero & Brig Peora Baker of Boston returned on board at 10 O'clock P.M. Middle & Latter parts the same so ends this day

Monday 17th

Commences today with a light breeze from the S. S. E. with fine pleasant weather vessel by the wind also steering N. & N. E. W. crew employed on ships duty saw two sails at sundown took in the light sails Middle part wind shifted to the S. W. Latter part steering E. saw five sails so ends this day

Tuesday 18th

Commences today with a light breeze from the S. W. with fine pleasant weather vessel steering E. crew employed taking down the stays 6 sails in sight at sundown took in the light sails for the night Middle & Latter parts light variable winds with rain squalls so ends this day

Wednesday 19th

Commences today with a light variable wind with cloudy rainy weather vessel steering different courses crew employed on ships duty saw two schools of Black fish porpoises. & three sails Middle part the same Latter part a strong breeze from the S. & steering different courses saw grampusses breaching so ends this day

Thursday 20th

Commences today with a strong breeze from the S. S. W. with cloudy weather free from rain vessel by the wind on different crew employed on ships duty saw two sails at sundown took in sail for the night Middle part heavy rain squalls from the S. W. Latter part wind the same free from squalls so ends this day

Friday 21st

Commences today with a moderate breeze from the S. W. with pleasant weather vessel by the wind on different tacks crew employed on ships duty saw 3 sails all whalers also saw cow fish at sundown took in sail for the night Middle & Latter parts a strong breeze from the S. W. saw nothing but 3 sails all whalers so ends this day

Saturday 22nd

Commences today with a strong breeze from the S. W. with a rugged sea vessel by the wind on different tacks crew employed on ships duty three whalers in sight at sundown took in sail for the night Middle part squally Latter part wind from the Westward one sail in sight a large merchantman saw nothing more so ends this day
