

June 20th 1889.
Moderate winds N.E. Brig
head S.E. Shorten sail nights.
Looking for White Whales

Sat 41-07 S. Long 58-54 W.

June 21st
Light breezes N.E. Brig
on different tacks

Sat. 41-48 S. Long 58-05 W.

June 22nd
First Light Easterly Winds Brig
head S.E. Latter. Strong winds
S.E.W. had N.E. always shorten
sail nights while on whale ground

Sat 42-04 S. Long 58-37 W.

June 23rd
Short port Calms Midder port
Wind N.E. & increased to a gale
Brig Head West.

June 24th
Moderate gales from N.E. Latter
port more moderate Brig head
N.E. heavy swell

June 25th
Winds Variable got sounding
in 28 fathoms fine sand & shell

June 26th
Fresh breezes from S.E.W. at
4 p.m. saw Land off N.E. side
dis. 10 miles. very low & broken land
in appearance

Sat. 42-00 S. Long 61-58 W.

June 27th
Strong breezes from S.E. brig
standing N.E. Land in sight
Heavy over falls extend 10 to 12
miles off shore

Sat. 42-12 S. Long 63-09 W.

June 28th
Light airs & calms Brig working to
S.E. Land in sight N.E. heavy
overfalls found Dredge to 200
fath put on a nice stop and set it up

Sat 43-06 S. Long 53-20 W.

June 29th
Moderate gales from N.E. Brig
off the mouth of New Bay Making up
in shore Land 6 to 10 miles off

June 30th
Strong breeze N.E. Brig off
New Bay sea seal and porpoises

July 1st
Light winds & calms Brig working
along the Sound N.E. & W. finish
fore top gallant sail put in one.
Clutch went to sent down lower
top sail for repair. Land 10 to 15 miles
dis.

July 2nd
Light airs from S.E. fine &
sent lower top sail. sent also
fore top mast staysail Brig heading
in for Hiden Strait

July 3rd
Light airs from East. co.
stood in between latter East & the
main deep anchor in 13 fathoms water
middle part heavy swell from the
East. Latter went on shore and got
57 seal all young dogs

July 4th
Light airs sea with a
Heavy swell from N.E. Latter
port went to the rock and in trying
to land got a boat turned over
and spore so rough could do no
Leaving came here land shifted
low
