

- Oct 8th 1855 fine pleasant weather Wind N.W. saw a hawk with fore legmost a bit lower. Steaming for port starting saw next is long lowing next E by S. at 25 miles.
- Oct 9th first port calm better for fine breeze from N.W. Ship heading N.W. 11th Got 50.52 Long 64.22
- Oct 10th light variable winds ship working to Westward Got 50.01 Long 64.12
- Oct 11th Wind N.W. Ship heading N.W. 11th E. sighted land Lat. 48.41
- fine pleasant weather wind N.W. were working along the land, the boat for top gallant sail.
- Oct 12th fine pleasant weather ship working along the land, the boat for top gallant sail.
- Oct 13th fine pleasant weather ship working along the land, the boat for top gallant sail.
- Oct 14th Westing wind sent boat in at anchor looking for seal saathas so. Better port calm.
- Oct 15th wind strong from S.E. with rain. Ship Lat. E. better short sail. Off port goes S.E.
- Oct 16th fine pleasant weather ship working to N.W. int. Gulf S. George. implies repairing windless. Shipper.
- Oct 17th fine weather variable winds. Cape morphology bearing N.W. 11th air is mild. Gotter port stand and along shore by Cape mops. halled of at dark.
- Oct 18th Moderate breeze from N.W. Ship heading N.W. hands employed repairing cold upper top sail. Better port variable winds with thunder, lightning & rain. Got 48.37 Long 66.21
- Oct 19th gales from west ship under storm sails. N.W. 11th Got 47.52 Long 65.03

- Oct 20th Strong Westing wind ship cast Eastern side
- Oct 21st Strong breeze from E. 16 With fog and rain. Ship head S.E.
- Oct 22nd Wind easterly fine pleasant weather. Ship head S.E. E. boarded English Brk. Herminie 16 day from Liverpool for Chile. Hands employed in repairing cold upper top sail. Lat. 46.31 Long 65.25
- Oct 23rd fine easterly weather ship at upper top sail. Lat. 47.52 Long 65.27
- Oct 24th Moderate Gale N. Ship head E. 16 Lat. 47.55 S. Gen 64.14
- Oct 25th Strong N.W. winds vessel by the end to the N.W. saw several hump backs and finback but no sign of white whale. Hands employed in repairing spare boat. Fixed the brig making more water than usual. Lat 47.11 S. 6 1.50 W
- Oct 26th Wind & current the same as above. Lat. 46.48 S. Long 67.23 W
- Oct 27th Strong Breeze from N.W. with fog & rain. great quantities of Sulphur Bottoms & pin. larks &c. Lat 45.39 S. Long 67.21 W
- Oct 28th fine weather. Cruising
- Oct 29th Calms at 6 a.m. John fish saw a large sperm whale. Lowered three boats. S.B. struck about noon. Killed & took to ship got him along side at dark. got supper set tables & get ready for cutting. Lat 45.42 S. Long 68.00 W
- Oct 30th at daylight Brisk breeze from S.W. commenced cutting wind increasing fast and sea rising rapidly took on the fore. Concluded to turn in the forenoon having the head for another time. Broke fast 11 p.m. to windless. put us back some hours, got upcast of the briddy had to quit before cutting stage & upper cutting block.
