

June 3<sup>rd</sup> 1891  
Light winds with pleasant weather seems to be the case just then at 5 p.m. fish haspenter rose sperm whales going quick to windward. S.W. and about 2 miles off. Lapped the log to the wind but it soon came at dark.

Lat - 34° 15' N.  
Long - 50° 45' W.

June 4<sup>th</sup>  
Light S.W. breeze being the wind working S.E.

Lat - 33° 34' N.  
Long - 49° 46' W.

June 5<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate winds from S.W. bent our sail. Batted port. Strong breeze being heading E.S.E. we pass through an abundance of cut squid every day.

Lat - 33° 44' N.  
Long - 47° 13' W.

June 6<sup>th</sup>  
Strong S.W. winds being head to the S.W.

Lat - 35° 42' N.  
Long - 47° 12' W.

June 7<sup>th</sup>  
Strong S.W. winds being steering different courses. Shorten sail every night at sunset.

Lat - 35° 45' N.  
Long - 47° 00' W.

June 8<sup>th</sup>  
Light winds from S.W. being steering different courses at dark lapped to windward sail.

Lat - 36° 27' N.  
Long - 47° 35' W.

June 9<sup>th</sup>  
Weather fine being cruising.

Lat - 35° 54' N.

June 10<sup>th</sup>  
Light air & calm  
Lat - 35° 50' N.

June 11<sup>th</sup>  
Light air & calm  
Lat 35° 25' N.  
Long - 46° 29' W.  
pass plenty of cut squid every day.

June 12<sup>th</sup>  
Light & moderate winds S.W. being steering S.W. winds inflamed in repairing fore sail.

Lat - 33° 53' N.  
Long - 45° 45' W.

June 13<sup>th</sup>  
Light air & calm found 3 chain plate bolts loose & working out under the fore chains made new ones drifted out the old ones and put in the new and corked the seams which were very slack under them.

Lat - 33° 15' N.  
Long - 44° 46' W.

June 14<sup>th</sup>  
Light S.W. air & calm Batted port. Winds N.W. Spike Bark Murremaid of New Bedford. Capt. Allen. One year out - 150 lbs sperm oil.

Lat - 32° 32' N.  
Long - 44° 55' W.

June 15<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate breeze from S.W. saw two large flocks of birds.

Lat - 32° 54' N.  
Long - 45° 10' W.

June 16<sup>th</sup>  
Pleasant weather with light winds.

Lat - 33° 35' N.  
Long - 44° 30' W.

June 17<sup>th</sup>  
Light winds S.W. Lat 34° 25' N.  
Long - 46° 31' W.

June 18<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze S.W. two sail in sight saw five backs. Lat 35° 00' N.  
Long - 45° 20' W.

June 19<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze from S.W. being steering S.W. things head N.W. Lat -

June 20<sup>th</sup>  
Strong S.W. winds being steering S.W. of drift stuff.
