Long. 47° 16' W.

July 18th Strong winds, S.W. breeze

boat to the ship and exchanged
for another got her ready Lat. 35° 50' N.

July 24th No cat. daylight, Cooper, hon
two sperm whales, lowered
the boats, S.B. struck took
him to the ship at 2 p.m. got
dinner, got ready and began to
cut at 4, cut off the head &
bore in the body & set the watch
having the head along side Lat.

July 25th Light air, & calm, heaved in and here
in the case & started the work.

July 26th Light air & calm, hands employed
in lading & lading case Lat. port
fin lading the oil from the case & got
it over board.

July 27th Moderate winds & pleasant weather
hands employed in lading &
pumping salt water out of ground
tier decks for salt water
Lat. 35° 45' N.
Long. 47° 49' W.

July 28th Light air & calm, hands employed
in lading & steering down
Lat. 36° 03' N.

July 29th Light air, fine weather, hands
employed in lading & steering down
Lat. 36° 04' N.

July 30th Light winds, good weather
finish lading & steering down
and changed ship, set sail in
night, in hole made, 136.6 lbs
Lat. 35° 51' N.
Long. 47° 31' W.

July 31st Fresh breeze with rain

Aug 1st Light winds, S.W. & S.E. W.
fine weather employed mending
Starboard boat, boarded a French
barge sent home letters
