Saturday Dec 27th

Commences with light breeze from the S.E. ward ship steering to the E.N.E. ward under all sail middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part steering to the Sward under all sail hands employed doing breaking out hold and bending old sails so ends Lat at Noon 21. 16 S Long " " 29. 03 W

Sunday Dec 28th

Commences with moderate breeze from E.S.E. ward ship steering to the Sward under all sail. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part steering S by W under all sail so ends Lat at Noon 22. 13 S Long " " 29. 40 W

Monday Dec 29th

Commences with light breeze from E.N.E. ward ship steering S by W under all sail. middle and latter parts light breeze from N.E. to E ship steering S under all sail hands employed doing ships duty. so ends Lat at Noon 23. 14 S Long " " 29. 06

Tuesday Dec 30th

Commences with light breeze from N.E. to N ship steering S under all sail. middle and latter parts steering S by W. hands employed sending down and bending sails so ends Lat at Noon 24. 30 Long " " 29. 00

Wednesday Dec 31st

Commences with light breeze from N.N.W. ward ship steering S by W under all sail. middle and latter parts the same hands employed doing ships duty. so ends Lat at Noon 26. 21 Long " " 28. 50

Thursday Jan 1st

Commences with moderate breeze from the N. ward ship steering S.E. W under all sail middle and latter parts the same hands employed doing ships duty. so ends Lat at Noon 27. 54 S Long " " 28. 53 W

Friday Jan 2nd

Commences with light breezes and rain squalls from the N.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail at sundown shortened sail for the night. at daylight made sail and steered to the westward. with a moderate breeze from the E. ward. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends Lat at Noon 28. 14 Long " " 29. 8

Saturday Jan 3rd

Commences with moderate breeze from E. ward ship steering to the W. ward under all sail (got one turtle this day) middle part ship laying to under easy sail. latter part steering to the N.N.W. ward under all sail. hands employed breaking out ships hold so ends Lat at Noon 28. 05 Long " " 29. 50

Sunday Jan 4th

Commences with moderate breeze from N.E. ward ship steering N.N.W. under all sail. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part steering S.E. by S under all sail so ends this day saw two finbacks Lat at Noon 28. 0 Long " " 30. 09

Monday Jan 5th

Commences with calms, and rain squalls from E. ward. middle part moderate breeze from N.E. ward ship laying to under short sail latter part moderate breeze from N.N.E. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward hands employed doing ships duty. Lat at Noon 28. 30 Long " " 29. 47
