Friday Jan 16<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. ward ship working to the N.W. ward under easy sail. saw four sails bound North & 1 south middle part laying to under easy sail latter part cruising on both tacks under all sail. saw several schools of grampuges. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends. Lat 29. 34 S

Long 42. 40 W

Saturday Jan 17<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from the S.W. ward. ship working to the Sward under all sail. sent down the fore top gallant sail and stowed it away. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part light air & calms ship working to the N.W. ward under all sail. saw one sail bound N. hands employed breaking out ships hold so ends. Lat at Noon 29. 57

Sunday Jan 18<sup>th</sup>

Commences with calms and light air from the Sward. ship working to the N.W. ward under all sail. at sundown shortened sail and lay to for the night. at daylight made sail and worked to the S.W. ward with a moderate breeze from the E ward so ends

Monday Jan 19<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate breeze from the E ward. ship steering S.W. under all sail. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part fresh breeze from N.E. ward ship working to the S.W. ward under short sail. saw 4 sails this day. 3 bound North & 1 south hands employed on ships duty so ends

Tuesday Jan 20<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. ward ship working to the S.W. ward under short sail. middle part ship laying to under easy sail. latter part working to the N.W. ward under short sail. saw three sails bound S. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends. Lat at Noon

Wednesday Jan 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with strong breeze from N.S.W. ward. ship steering to the S.W. ward under easy sail. middle part ship laying to under short sail. latter part working to the Sward under easy sail. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Lat at Noon 31. 04 S

Thursday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with light breeze from N.W. ward ship working to the S.W. ward under all sail. at sundown shortened sail & lay to for the night. at daylight made sail and steered to the S.W. ward under all sail. with a light breeze from the S.E. ward. so ends

Lat at Noon 31. 04

Friday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with light breeze from the S.E. ward. ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part steering to the S.E. ward under all sail. with moderate breeze from the E ward so ends

Lat at Noon 31. 45

Saturday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh breeze from the S.E. ward ship steering to the Sward under all sail. saw 7 sails bound South. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part fresh breeze from E. ward ship steering to the Nward under all sail. hands breaking out hold so ends
