Commences with fresh breeze from S.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward under easy sail. Middle part laying to under short sail. latter part moderate breeze from S.W. ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Tuesday Jan 27th

Commences with moderate breeze from S.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail. Middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part moderate breeze from N.W. ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Commences with moderate breeze from S.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward middle part laying to under short sail. latter part light breeze from N.W. ship steering to the S.W. ward hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Commences with light winds and thunder squalls with rain. ship steering to the S.W. ward under easy sail. Middle part moderate breeze from S.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward under easy sail. latter part the same hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Friday Jan 30th

Commences with moderate breeze from S.W. ward ship steering by the wind on both tacks under all sail. Middle part shortened sail and steered to the E ward with strong breeze from the N.W. ward latter part the same so ends

Saturday Jan 31st

Commences with strong breeze from S.W. to N. ship steering to the E ward under all prudent sail middle and latter parts the same. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends

Latt at Noon 31. 05

Sunday Feb 1st

Commences with fresh breeze from S.W. ward ship steering to the E ward under all prudent sail. at 6 P.M. saw several spouts. whales (supposed to be sperm) working to windward faster than the ship could work up at 7.30 shortened sail and worked to the windward on different tacks. at daylight made sail and steered to the E ward with strong breeze from N.W. so ends

Monday Feb 2nd

Commences with strong breeze from N.W. ship steering to the E ward under all prudent sail. Middle and latter parts fresh gale from the S.W. ward ship hove to heading to the S.W. ward. so ends

Commences with fresh gale from the S.W. ward ship hove to heading to the S.W. ward middle part the same. latter part moderate breeze from the S.W. ward ship steering to the S.W. ward under all sail. hands employed doing ships duty. so ends
