Tuesday March 23rd

Commences with a fresh breeze from N.E. ward with cloudy weather. ship steering N by W under all prudent sail. middle and latter parts the same hands employed doing ships duty so ends Latt at Noon 8. 50 Long .. " 34. 40

Wednesday March 24th

Commences with strong breeze with cloudy weather from N.E. ward ship steering N by W under all prudent sail. middle part the same. latter part steering by the wind to the N ward under all prudent sail unbet the fore top gallant sail hands employed doing ships duty so ends. Latt at Noon 10. 49 Long .. " 36. 00

Thursday March 25th

Commences with strong breeze and cloudy weather from E.N.E ship steering by the wind to the N ward under all prudent sail. middle and latter parts steering by the wind to the N ward under reefed topsails & courses with a strong breeze so ends Latt at Noon 12. 08 Long .. " 36. 40

Friday March 26th

Commences with strong breeze from E.N.E ward ship steering by the wind to the N ward under short sail. middle part the same. latter part steering to the N.W. ward under easy sail hands employed doing ships duty so ends Latt at Noon 12. 52 Long .. " 37. 20

Saturday March 27th

Commences with strong breeze from E.N.E ship steering to the N ward under easy sail. middle part laying to heading to the N ward latter part steering by the wind to the N ward under easy sail saw two sails Latt at Noon 12. 36 Long 37. 50

Sunday March 28th

Commences with fresh breeze from N.E. ward ship cruising under easy sail. spoke Bark E B Phillips no oil since we spoke her last. middle part laying to under easy sail. latter part cruising so ends Latt at Noon 12. 45 Long .. " 37. 40

Monday March 29th

Commences with strong breeze from N.E. ward ship cruising under easy sail spoke E B Phillips. middle part laying to heading to the N.E. ward. at 6.30 A.M. saw the E B Phillips with her boats down. whaling made sail and stood towards them. whales going to leeward quick did not get near enough to lower at 12.30 M. luffed up and stood along by the wind. hands employed doing ships duty so ends Latt at Noon 12. 09 Long .. " 37. 40

Tuesday March 30th

Commences with strong breeze from N.E. ward ship steering by the wind to the N ward under all prudent sail. at sundown shortened sail and lay to at day-light made sail and steered different courses. cruising. hands employed doing ships duty so ends Latt at Noon 12. 16 Long .. " 37. 56

Wednesday March 31st

Commences with strong breeze from N.E. ward ship steering to the N.W. ward under all prudent sail. middle part laying to under short sail. latter part steering different courses under all prudent sail hands employed doing ships duty so ends Latt 12. 23 George Finn returned to the galley as cook again Long 38. 00
