Friday May 13th 14th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius employed sending top gallant mast and main, topsail, & top gallant yards aloft and setting up rigging.

Saturday May 14th 15th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius employed painting ships buns, tarring down rigging & setting up main top mast rigging Starboard watch on shore on liberty.

Sunday May 15th 16th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius Starboard watch ashore on liberty. 7 Borden boatmen, 7 Miller Cooper, James Matthews Christian Joseph & Antonio Medas seamen belonging to the Starboard watch did not come on board engaged two men to pull the boat & one to cook from ashore paid off the two at night.

Monday May 16th 17th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius Employed painting ships buns and main top & top gallant masts & yards & in tarring down rigging etc. J. Hastings & A Osborne of the Starboard watch did not come on board. Starboard watch ashore on liberty.

Tuesday May 17th 18th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius Starboard watch ashore on liberty. engaged one man from ashore to work on board. employed in rattling down main topmast rigging and tarring down.

Wednesday May 18th 19th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius hands employed in tarring down rigging painting head of main topmast and rattling main topmast rigging & preparing starboard side of ship for painting.

Thursday May 19th 20th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius. employed in painting ships buns & masts. rattling & tarring down. John Espinola off duty Sick

Friday May 20th 21st

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius employed in painting, tarring, rattling down and such like. John Espinola off duty Sick

Saturday May 21st 22nd

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius employed in painting, rattling down and general work. John Espinola off duty.

Sunday May 22nd 23rd

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius. John Espinola Sick

Monday May 23rd 24th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius hands employed bending sails and general work, one more man from ashore at work half a day. John Espinola Sick

Tuesday May 24th 25th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius hands employed in getting ship ready for sea two shore men at work on board

Wednesday May 25th 26th

Lying at anchor in St Eustatius getting ready for sea at 10.30 AM. hove short. at 5 P.M. got under way and stood for sea. received on board Wm. St. Moore as steward and Luther Swift as passenger so ends this day of 14 hours Civil Ace
