Saturday June 4<sup>th</sup>

Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. ward ship steering N under all sail. Middle part baffling wind latter part the same vessel working to the N ward under all sail. so ends  
J. Espinda sick. Lat at noon 29. 16  
Long " 64. 22

Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from the N ward ship by the wind heading to the N.W. ward under all sail. at 4 P.M. furled light sails middle part moderate breeze from the N ward heading to the N.W. ward latter part the same at daylight made all sail. so ends  
Lat at noon 29. 40  
Long " 64. 55

Monday June 6<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from the N ward ship by the wind heading to the N.W. ward under all sail. middle part light airs from S.E. to S.W. ship steering N. latter part light winds from the N.W. ward steering N under all sail. so ends  
J. Espinda well & on duty Lat at noon 29. 54  
Long " 64. 46

Tuesday June 7<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light airs from N.W. varying to W.N.W. ship by the wind heading to the N ward under all sail middle & latter parts moderate breeze from the N ward ship steering N 1/2 W under all sail. saw on steamer bound S. so ends. Lat at noon 30. 58

Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from the N ward ship steering N by W under all sail. middle part the same. at 3 A.M. took in light sail & lay to under topsails & jib at 4.30 braced forward & made sail steered N by W. & N so ends  
Lat by Gal 32. 03  
Long " 65. 05

Thursday June 9<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong breeze from the S. N ward ship steering to the S.E. ward under reefed topsails & fore topmast stay set at 6 P.M. come up thick & squally with rain. at 8.30 raised the light on the Island of Bermuda bearing S.E. by S. middle part laying to. latter part took on board a pilot at 4 A.M. and stood for St. Georges. at 11 A.M. the health officers came alongside and returned to shore again ship laying off & on waiting for a bill of health so ends this day

Friday June 10<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh breeze from the N ward ship laying off & on at the island of Bermuda pilot on board at daylight stood in shore and lay to at 10.30 A.M. a boat came alongside from ashore bringing bill of health and permit to land the pilot and passenger. towed the barboard boat and landed them boat returned at 1 P.M.
