

Log of Bark Mattapoisett of New

Sunday July 4th

Lying at anchor at Fayal
had strong breeze from the S ward let
go the second anchor. Had one man come
on board as seaman.

Monday July 5th

Lying at anchor at Fayal
two seamen and a cook came on board
to day.

Tuesday July 6th

Lying at anchor at Fayal
took up the port anchor.

Wednesday July 7th

Lying at anchor at Fayal
had two men come on board this day.

Thursday July 8th

Lying at anchor at
Fayal had one seaman come on board
this day. Tossed the sails and prepared to
get under weigh this day ends at 12 noon
to commence the sea day.

Friday July 9th

Lying at anchor at
Fayal. at 4 P.M. got under weigh.
Set all sail and steered S at 4 P.M. set
the watches. light breeze from the N E ward
middle and latter parts the same. at 9
A.M. raised a school of sperm whales
lowered S board & waist boats. and
struck one, killed and took him to the
ship.

Saturday July 10th

took whale alongside
at 7 P.M. made him fast and stood
off shore under all sail. middle part
the same got the gear ready and

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Commenced to cut at 7 A.M.

Sunday July 11th

Commenced with
moderate breeze from the S ward
hands employed cutting in whale. middle
and latter parts the same so ends

Monday July 12th

Commenced with
moderate breeze from N. S. W. finished cutting
whale. at 7 P.M. middle and latter parts
the same employed boiling whale so ends

Tuesday July 13th

Commenced with
light breeze from the N ward employed in
boiling middle and latter parts variable
winds

Wednesday July 14th

Commenced with
light variable winds. hands employed
boiling whale. middle and latter parts the
same

Thursday July 15th

Commenced with fresh
breeze with light squalls from the N E ward
on different tacks off the Island of Pico.
employed boiling and stowing oil. middle
and latter parts the same so ends

Friday July 16th

Commenced with variable
winds. on different tacks off Pico employed in
boiling and stowing oil. finished boiling at
12.30 A.M. latter part employed in clearing
up decks
