

Log of "Bark Mattapoisett" of New

Saturday Aug 14th

Commences with moderate breeze from the E. ward. off Terceira boiling. finished boiling at 3 P.M. middle and latter parts the same employe stowing oil & ends

Sunday Aug 15th

Commences with light winds from the E. ward off Terceira under easy sail. middle part calms & light winds. latter moderate breeze from the N. ward cruising on different tacks. Terceira at noon bearing N. distant 9 miles

Monday Aug 16th

Commences with moderate breeze from the N. ward cruising on different tacks to the S. ward of Terceira under easy sail middle part the same. latter strong breeze from the N. E. ward working towards Terceira under all prudent sail & ends

Tuesday Aug 17th

Commences with fresh breeze from N. E. ward. under easy sail working towards Terceira. distant at 4 P.M. 5 miles bearing N. middle and latter parts the same. at 9 A.M. the captain went ashore taking

Wednesday Aug 18th

Commences with fresh breeze from S. E. ward. lying off & on at Angra waiting for the Captain boat returned at 8 P.M. middle and latter parts strong breeze from the N. ward working towards Fayal under easy sail

Thursday Aug 19th

Commences with strong breeze from the S. ward. steering to the N. ward under easy sail. middle and latter parts lying to under the lee of Pico on different tacks under easy sail with a fresh gale from the S. ward & ends

Friday Aug 20th

Commences with fresh breeze from the N. ward on different tacks under easy sail Pico at 4 P.M. 6 miles off bearing N. saw grampuses. middle the same. latter part blowing fresh from all round the compass. under easy sail to the S. E. ward of Pico. & ends

Saturday Aug 21st

Commences with fresh gale from different points. lying under easy sail to the S. E. ward of Pico. middle part the same. latter part steering to the N. ward with moderate breeze from the N. ward under all prudent sail

Sunday Aug 22nd

Commences with moderate breeze from the N. ward. steering N. under easy sail. middle part lying to on different tacks. latter part moderate breeze from E. N. E. ship steering to the N. ward under all sail. Fayal at noon bearing N. E. by E. by compass distant 25 miles & ends

Monday Aug 23rd

Commences with light winds from E. N. E. steering to the S. ward under all sail. middle part took in light sail. latter part steering to the E. N. E. with moderate breeze from the N. ward
