

Log of Bark Mattaprisett of New

Tuesday Aug 24th

Commences with moderate breeze from the N. ward. ship steering to the S. N. E. under all sail. Lay off at 4 P. M. bearing S. E. distant 15 miles. middle part by the wind under easy sail. latter part steering to the E. ward under easy sail. so ends

Wednesday Aug 25th

Commences with moderate breeze from N. N. W. steering E. under all sail. middle part shortened sail & lay to on different tacks. latter part strong breeze from the N. ward steering to the S. E. ward under easy sail

Thursday Aug 26th

Commences with strong breeze from the N. ward. steering to the S. E. ward under easy sail. middle part lying to. latter part light breeze from the N. ward steering by the wind to the N. ward under all sail. so ends

Friday Aug 27th

Commences with light breeze from the N. ward steering by the wind to the N. ward under all sail. middle part shortened sail & lay to. latter part cruising on different tacks by the wind between Graciosa & Terceira under all sail. so ends

Saturday Aug 28th

Commences with light breeze from the E. ward steering to the S. ward under all sail. middle part lay to under easy sail. latter part steering different courses with light baffling winds. Terceira at noon bearing S. distant 6 miles

Sunday Aug 29th

Commences with light baffling winds steering different courses to the N. ward of Terceira spoke Sch. Alcione off P. town. middle part shortened sail & lay to latter part steering different courses under all sail. Terceira at noon bearing S. dist 6 miles. saw two sails

Monday Aug 30th

Commences with fresh breeze & thick foggy weather from the N. E. ward working to the S. ward of Terceira under easy sail. middle the same. latter part moderate breeze from the E. ward steering to the S. ward by the wind under easy sail

Tuesday Aug 31st

Commences with light winds from the E. ward steering to the S. E. ward under all sail. middle part shortened sail & lay to. latter part steering to the S. E. ward with moderate breeze from the S. W. St Michael at noon 25 miles off bearing S. S. E.

Wednesday Sept 1st

Commences with light breeze from the S. E. ward. steering N. N. W. under all sail. middle part shortened sail. latter part steering N. N. W. saw two sails.
