Monday Nov 1st
fine weather employed in breaking out
main hatch sent down foretop sail and
lent the other one rose new foretop sail buntlines
& the American Consul came on board and
shipped eight men the Bks Manning Star
and President sailed and Bks Peru and
A R. Tucker arrived

Tuesday Nov 2nd
fine weather employed in breaking out fore
hole discharged John Glover stowed sick
with the clothes & ends

Wednesday Nov 3rd
fine weather employed in breaking out and
setting up shooks and stowing hole washing ships
bells & broke out bread & 2 so ends

Thursday Nov 4th
fine weather employed in hauling ship out
into 9 fathoms cleaning chains stowing hole &

Friday Nov 5th
fine weather employed in various odd jobs the
mail arrived tidly painting mizzen topmast
mizzen paint for ship

Saturday Nov 6th
fine weather employed in painting part side of
ship and overhead boat took on board sugar
potatoes and pumpkins & 2 so ends

Sunday Nov 7th
fine weather the crew on shore on a run
night seven men and one boatman in shore
three men & one arrived tidly

Monday Nov 8th
fine weather employed in hauling ship out
into 16 fathoms painting part side of ship and
head gear took on board some wood and sent
a tin of kerosine ashore &

Tuesday Nov 9th
raining some tide employed in painting starboard
side of ship turned the Waist boat over and
took off the copper and got her ready for painting
and other odd jobs & ends

Wednesday Nov 10th
raining some employed in painting Waist boat
and stern of ship put out a overhead boat
in harbor drains and various odd jobs

Thursday Nov 11th
fine weather employed in painting Starboard
side of ship and waist boat took on board
seventy barrels water lent a new gaff top sail
rose new halliards & and 2 so ends

Friday Nov 12th
fine weather employed in getting new foreboard
boat ready for whaling turned the waist boat
right side up and finished painting her and
various odd jobs & 2 so ends

Saturday Nov 13th
fine weather employed in taking in the
old boat and put her on the head painted
new overhead boat and covered her took on
board 2 coals engines and two runaway men
put them in irons down in the blower run
ship all ready for sea the counsel came
in board and shipped one man & ends
