

Remarks On Board Bark

Sunday Nov 14th
fine weather strong breeze blowing in shore
at 5 AM here in 10 thirty fathoms of chain
and loosed sails at 9 AM gave her forty
fathoms took the two men out of irons and
at clock put them in again so ends

Monday Nov 15th
fine weather at 4 AM called all hands
and got under weigh and hauled out and
towed out at 7 AM got a breeze from the
Eastward lashed the anchors and stowed
chains steering SSW the Bk Seine and
Sch H M Simmons came out at the same
time at 8 AM maned mastheads saw an
steamer and blackfish took the men out
of irons this morning at 6 PM steering SSW
Genesife bearing N so ends

Tuesday Nov 16th
fine weather light breeze from NE steering
SW saw one sail employed in various odd
jobs at 4 PM steering SSW
Lat 24.39 N
Long 16.50 W

Wednesday Nov 17th
fine weather stiff breeze from NE steering
SW saw finbacks and porpoises
employed in breaking out beef pork and water
Lat 24.27 N
Long 18.32 W

Thursday Nov 18th
fine weather moderate breeze from the ENE
steering SW 1/2 W employed in reshaping cutting
blocks with chain stops and various odd jobs
5 PM steering SSW Lat 22.47 N
Long 20.01 W

Friday Nov 19th
smoky weather stiff breeze from the Eastward
steering SSW 1/2 W employed in various
odd jobs in ship duty
Lat 20.24 N
Long 20.30 W D R

Saturday Nov 20th
rainy squally weather with the winds varying
from S E to N first light then stiff at 6 PM
stiff breeze from the Eastward took in light sails
and put one reef in the topsails steering SSW
employed in picking oysters saw porpoises
6 PM steering SSW Lat 18.25 N D R
Long 21.20 W

Sunday Nov 21st
stiff breeze made sail at 11 PM last night today
stiff breeze from NE steering SSW 1/2 W at 3 PM
steering SSW trying to find the land at 5 PM
the mainmast the ported repaired it
at 6 PM steering SSW Lat 16.08 N
Long 21.13 W

Monday Nov 22nd
stiff breeze from NE at 1 AM took in light sails
at 3 AM steering W at daylight the island of Nepe
in sight bearing NW could not pitch it and kept
away for St. Jago at 2.30 PM the Capt went ashore
at Forte Praya sunset the boat came off with some
oranges the Bk Seine and a whaling Sch are going
off and on here night the Capt ashore ship going
off and on

Tuesday Nov 23rd
strong breeze going off and on took on shore 2 lbs
tea two bags flour three bags bread and a bucket
of potatoes took on board some oranges two pigs
and eight men night going off and in the Capt
ashore Bk Seine left for south Bk Pormaid
going off and on so ends
