Sunday Dec 5th
moderate breeze from the ENE steering SSW
S & G V B & G W saw porpoises and
one brig
Leat 12 25 N
Long 21.32 W

Monday Dec 6th
moderate breeze from NNE steering SSW
saw porpoises blackfish and one ship
employed in coaling small line for S Boat
Leat 10.51 N
Long 21.22 W

Tuesday Dec 7th
moderate breeze from NE steering SSW saw
sulphur bottoms and porpoises employed in
mending old topsail
Leat 9.25 N
Long 21.07 W

Wednesday Dec 8th
moderate breeze from all quarters with stand-
ing light breeze and rain saw blackfish
one and the V and W boats got one apiece
the S Boat struck one and the iron barge
cleared the fish away sunset wind NNE
steering SSW so ends

Thursday Dec 9th
moderate breeze from NE steering SSW
saw one sail and one steamer employed in
breaking out water bread pork beans and
dried apples and trying out blackfish finished
at dark made
Leat 7.41 N
Long 21.28 W

Friday Dec 10th
moderate breeze from ENE steering SSW
saw blackfish and porpoises employed in
mending old topsail finished and bent it
forward and bent the foretopsail at the main
sunset took in light sails for a thimble
storm 7 PM wind SSW so ends
three men off duty
Leat 5.47 N
Long 21.32 W
if you can tell
their names you will do well

Saturday Dec 11th
moderate breeze from the Eastward steering
SSW at 4 PM wind to the Northward
heading on port tack cloudy employed in
ship duty
No Observations

Sunday Dec 12th
light breeze from all quarters heading nowhere
in particular working to the Southward saw
nothing during the same
Leat 4.44 N
Long 22.14 W

Monday Dec 13th
men calm and light air until 2 PM then a rain
all around squall and breeze from the Eastward steering
SSW saw grampas and porpoises at 7 PM
light air and cloudy
No Observations

Tuesday Dec 14th
light breeze from the Eastward heading anywhere
from SSW to SSW saw blackfish grampas
porpoises and two ships employed in odd jobs
Leat 3.45 N
Long 22.09 W
