one sail employed in painting iron work
outside

and muzzum topmast stays new straps to
the main brace blocks last night Pedro

put him in irons again Lat 27.30 S
Long 28.57 W

Saturday Feb 5th
stiff breeze from N.E. heading from N to N.W.
at 12 M more ship heading E.S.E. under ~~loose~~
topsails at 2 P.M. set whole topsails saw one
sail employed in breaking out at dark put
Pedro in irons Lat 26.28 S
Long 29.22 W

Sunday Feb 6th
light airs and variable under all sail in
different tacks saw one sail Put Pedro
in irons at dark Lat 26.32 S
Long 28.34 W

Monday Feb 7th
moderate breeze from N.E. heading E.S.E.
saw one sail Pedro employed in grounding
anchors sunset in irons Lat 26.43 S
Long 27.33 W

Tuesday Feb 8th
moderate breeze from the Eastward heading
to the Northward employed in overhauling
main topsail brace blocks reeve new fore top
gallant halliards bent new fly jib Pedro
cleaning wheel sunset in irons
saw one sail Lat 26.17 S
Long 27.52 W
