Saturday June 4th
fresh breezes from N.E. to E.N.E.
heading to the N.W.ward under all
sail saw two sails bound S.W.ward
employed in ship duty Lat 22 30 N
Long 24.19 W

Sunday June 5th
moderate breeze from N.W. to N.E.
heading to the N.W.ward saw porpoises
and one sail bound W.ward
Lat 23 45 N
Long 26.02 W

Monday June 6th
light breeze from N.E. to S.W. at 10 A.M.
tacked ship heading to the E.ward saw two
sails bound W.ward saw finbacks blackfish
turtle and a log Capt. Leavest and caught
one fish Lat 24 09 N
Long 26.42 W

Tuesday June 7th
moderate breeze from N.E. heading on
different tacks saw one two sails bound
S.W. saw finbacks and porpoises employed
in ship duty Lat 24.33 N
Long 26.53 W

Wednesday June 8th
morning foggy later fine weather wind
to the E.N.E. heading to the S.W.ward under
all sail employed in ship duty
Lat 24 55 N
Long 26.24 W

Thursday June 9th
light breezes from the E.ward and squally
heading to the S.W.ward saw sulphur porpoises
and one turtle (caught him) employed in mending
main topmast staysail and bent it Lat 25 40 N
Long 26.52 W

Friday June 10th
light breezes from E.N.E. to E. and foggy
saw one sail bound E.ward employed
in various jobs at 3 P.M. the island of St. P.
Michels bearing N.E. 4 N 8 1/2 miles distant
the island Terceira N.W. 1/2 E 118 miles
Lat 26 45 N
Long 27.00 W

Saturday June 11th
light airs and calms saw one steamer one
sail finbacks porpoises and the islands
of St. Marys St. Michels and Terceira
employed in repairing spare topsail finished
Lat 27.38 N
Long 27.25 W

Sunday June 12th
calms and light airs varying from S.E. to
W. saw finbacks porpoises one steamer and
the island of St. Michels at sunset N. 1
of duty point bearing E. 1/2 S 25 miles distant
sick the mate standing
his watch Lat 27.27 N noon
Long 27.25 W

Monday June 13th
moderate breezes from the W.ward steering
E. 1/2 N, E. and E. 1/2 S saw finbacks porpoises
two sails and the island of St. Michels
passed to the W.ward of it Lat 28.12 N
Long 25.31 W

Tuesday June 14th
moderate breeze varying from S.W. to W. steering
E. 1/2 S 1/2 W saw porpoises finbacks turtles and
one sail employed in breaking out hole
Lat 28.30 N
Long 23.15 W
