Thursday June 15th
fresh breezes from the Westward steering
S.E. saw grampius finbacks porpoises and
two sails (one a whaler) spoke by Harpoon
De Will Capt Silva cutting 2 months
out 228. At sunset took in sail by the wind
heading S. watch Lat 37.58 N
Leng none

Friday June 17th
fresh breezes from the Westward heading
in different tacks saw two sails (one a
whaler) employed in overhauling purchase
blocks &c Lat 38.10 N
Leng 18.14 W

Saturday June 18th
moderate breezes from the N.W. saw
finbacks two sail (one a whaler) and the
portuguese mail steamer Reine bound E. ward
employed in ship duty Lat 38.24 N
Leng 17.48 W

Sunday June 19th
fine weather with moderate breeze from S.W.
slung various courses saw grampius and
one whaler so ends Lat 38.18 N
Leng 17.26 W

Monday June 20th
fresh breezes from the N.W. and foggy
heading in different tacks saw one whaler
employed in ship duty Lat 37.46 N
Leng 17.02 W

light breezes from N.W. & S.W. and foggy
heading in different tacks saw two sails
one a whaler employed in ship duty
Lat 37.33 N
Leng 17.22 W

Wednesday June 22nd
fine weather with a moderate breeze from
the N.W. heading in different tacks saw
finback porpoises and one whaler employed
in ship duty Lat 37.43 N
Leng 17.54 W

Thursday June 23rd
light airs from the N.W. and fine weather
heading to the N.W. saw four sails (three
whalers) employed in middle sheeting fore
topmast staysail Lat 37.48 N
Leng 18.27 W

Friday June 24th
fine weather A.M. calm P.M. light breezes from
the N.W. heading in different tacks saw a
carrack three sails (one a whaler) employed in
repairing mainsail and bent it bent the fore
topmast staysail Lat 37.58 N
Leng 18.50 W

Saturday June 25th
light breezes from the N.W. and foggy
heading to the E. ward saw finbacks clupfish
six sails (one a whaler) and a spar (picked it up)
employed in ship duty Lat 38.05 N
Leng 18.05 W

Sunday June 26th
A.M. foggy 10 A.M. cleared up with a fresh
breeze from the N.W. heading to the E. ward
saw porpoises and twelve sails (one a whaler)
Lat 38.00 N
Leng 17.09 W
