with 450 bbl Lat 34.34 N

rainy weather with a fresh breeze from S W
to N W heading on different tacks under
reefed topsails and foresail saw one whaler
employed in ship duty
Lat 34.54 N
Long 48.13 W

Thursday Sept 8th
cloudy weather with some rain at 6 P.M.
with variable westerly winds heading on
different tacks under all sail saw one
whaler employed in straightening rattens
on fore rigging bent spare topsail forward
sunset rainy Lat 34.32 N
Long 48.27 W

Friday Sept 9th
cloudy weather with occasional rain with a
moderate breeze from W to N heading on
Starboard tack under topsails and courses
saw one whaler spoke Bk Steine and took
1/2 cord of wood from her sunset two reefed
the topsails and furled courses
Lat 34.06 N
Long 48.44 W

N to N W heading on different tacks under
easy sail saw nothing doing the same

Monday Sept 12th
cloudy weather with all kinds of wind with
some rain wind S E heading on different tacks
under easy sail saw one sail employed in tarring
main topgallant rigging &c
Lat 34.00 N
Long 49.55 W

Tuesday Sept 13th
cloudy weather with a strong breeze from
the Sward heading on different tacks under
one reefed topsails and foresail employed in
breaking out hole sunset two reefed the topsails
and furled foresail Lat 33.45 N
Long 49.52 W

Wednesday Sept 14th
fair weather with a fresh breeze from S E
and rugged heading to the Sward under reefed
topsails and courses saw one sail employed in
breaking up old boat and various other jobs
Lat 34.25 N
Long 49.06 W
