Wednesday Oct 5th

a gale of wind at 9 P.M. last night took
in light sails and reefed topsails which
hauled to the N more ship at 8 A.M.
furled courses and close reefed topsails
at 6 A.M. furled foretopsail and gave
venge the mains at 4 P.M. set main
topsail. Lat 38.53 N. Doubtless
saw two sails. Long 70.38 W.

Thursday Oct 6th

fine weather at 10 A.M. wind moderating set
foretopsail at 4 A.M. set courses at 8 A.M. all sail
set with a baffling wind from N.W. at 10 P.M.
looked ship heading to the Nward saw two
sails employed in ship duty.

Friday Oct 7th

fine weather with a baffling wind from
N.W. to W heading to the Nward under all
sail saw finbacks and two sails at 2.30 P.M.
Saw 4 Pigs light ship bore N.W. 98 miles
distant at 4 P.M. steering N.W. by N

Long 70.33 W

Saturday Oct 8th

fine weather with a moderate breeze from
S.W. steering N.W. by N at 9 A.M. saw
Bloss Island light at 9 P.M. took a pilot
got up cable and got ready the anchors
to end the voyage
