 Friday Nov. 18<sup>th</sup> 1881

Lat. N. First part strong breeze and pleasant  
 22.50 Middle part strong breeze saw five sails  
 Long. W. Latter part strong breeze from E.N.E. the  
 38.03 Bark steering by the wind on the Port  
 tack heading from S.E. to S.S.E.

Saturday Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. First part strong breeze from E.N.E.  
 21.54 Middle part strong breeze and cloudy  
 Long. W. Latter part strong breeze saw a sail steering  
 37.20 to the Northwest and saw jammers. so  
 ends this 24 hours steering by the wind  
 heading from S.S.E. to S.E.

Sunday Nov. 20<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. First part fresh breeze from E.N.E.  
 20.12 the Bark steering by the wind on the  
 Long. W. Port tack heading S.S.E. middle part  
 36.33 strong breeze Latter part strong breeze  
 the Bark steering by the wind under single  
 reefed Topsails & Courses jib and Spenters

Monday Nov. 21<sup>st</sup>

Lat. N. These 24 hours light Gale from about  
 18.54 East. the Bark steering by the wind  
 Long. W. on the Port tack heading from S.E.  
 35.53 to S.E. the Bark under single reefed  
 Topsails and Courses

Tuesday Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup>

Lat. N. These 24 hours light Gale from East  
 17.52 with a few light squalls of rain  
 Long. W. saw a white water streaked for it  
 35.29 but saw nothing more suppose it  
 to be Grampuses so ends this 24  
 hours the Bark steering by the  
 wind on the Port tack under single  
 reefed Topsails and Courses heading  
 about S.E. E.

Journal of *New Bedford* Capt. *Stikner*  
*Barnes* to the West Coast of Africa  
 Wednesday Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> 1881

First part light Gale and some  
 squalls saw a Merchant Bark steering  
 to the southward Middle part strong  
 breeze and much wind East latter  
 part strong breeze the Bark steering by  
 the wind on the Port tack heading  
 S.E. under close Reefed foretopsail  
 Courses jib and Spenters saw a sail  
 steering to the Southward

Thursday Nov. 24<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. These 24 hours strong breeze and  
 another squall Wind East the Bark  
 Long. W. steering by the wind on the Port tack  
 40 under whole maintopsail and Courses  
 08 jib and Spenters heading S.E.

Friday Nov. 25<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. First part light Gale and cloudy  
 36 Wind E.N.E. Bark heading S.E. Middle  
 Long. W. part strong breeze sent in the jib and  
 13 reefed it Latter part strong breeze  
 sent. The jib again sends the Bark  
 steering by the wind on the Port tack  
 heading S.E. and S.E. by S.

Saturday Nov. 26<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. These 24 hours strong breeze.  
 20 the Bark steering by the wind  
 Long. W. under single reefed Topsails wind  
 14 Courses jib Wind E.N.E. Weather  
 thick and cloudy saw a sail  
 steering to the Westward

Sunday Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>

Lat. N. First part strong breeze from East Middle  
 50 part Moderate Gale from the Eastward the  
 Long. W. Bark steering by the wind on the Port tack  
 56 heading S.E. E. and of the time latter part  
 the same
